available and *you may also bring your own chairs to insure a comfortable distance from each other*. There are restrooms (the real kind) near the parking lot.

Gabriel Park is a 90-acre park located near Multnomah Village in Southwest Portland. The entire southern portion of the Park is a lovely woods with dirt trails. The paths through the rest of the park are paved. Please Note: It is unlawful to possess or consume alcohol in any Portland park without a permit and EDSO does not have a permit for this event.

We will meet at the northeast portion of Gabriel Park located at 42nd Avenue and Vermont St. From Vermont Street, turn south on 42nd Ave. which directly enters the park. Then, go left to park.
