- Instructs/trains equipment operators on the operation and care of mowing and other equipment; participates in pesticide applications and/or operates and calibrates pesticide application equipment; and supervises and participates in the operation and maintenance of pumps, and in the maintenance of irrigation and drainage systems.
- Assists in personnel management and evaluation, staff safety and personnel discipline.
- May modify the daily works schedule based on professional interpretation.
