It's that time of year again! The 21st Annual North Carolina Blueberry Festival is just around the corner and we are excited to celebrate this milestone! Thank you so much for your interest in participating in our event.

Our board of directors and various committees have been working diligently to make the 2024 festival our best yet. We aim to keep things new and exciting, as well as incorporate our small-town atmosphere that everyone loves. Unfortunately, we cannot accept every applicant due to the limited amount of space in our charming historic downtown district. Therefore, we select vendors on a "first come, first served" basis. This year, we will be very mindful of the variety of products offered to avoid having too many vendors with duplicate goods. We encourage you to incorporate blueberries, agriculture, or even just the color blue into your products! Numerous changes have been made to our application, so please review the following information carefully. We highly recommend keeping a copy of this application for future reference. DATE, TIME, AND PLACE: Historic Courthouse Square in downtown Burgaw, NC. (100 S Wright Street) Arts and Crafts Vendors will be permitted to set up on Friday, June 14th at 5:30pm and must set up Saturday, June 15th by 7am, and must be ready to sell from 9am to 6pm. Attendance is a commitment to show during these hours. *Friday's showing time is subject to change. <u>There will be no early closing of booths.</u>

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APPLICATION INFORMATION: Fee is \$175 per booth. Booth space is 10 x 10 ft. (Early bird fee is \$150 post-marked by March 20th) Final application deadline is May 1st. Any applications accepted after the deadline will be assessed an additional \$25 administrative fee.

Electricity Fee: \$25.00 additional fee per hook-up. Electrical hook-ups are limited in quantity and location. The fee is to be added to and included with your booth fee payment. You must bring your own extension cords to the festival. *Please note that some booth locations are several yards/feet away from electrical hook-up. Make sure you bring enough extension cord.*

NO GENERATORS OF ANY KIND WILL BE ALLOWED!!

ELIGIBILITY OF WORK:

- 1. ITEMS MUST BE <u>HANDMADE</u> BY ARTIST SHOWING SAME. NO BUY/SELL PRODUCTS.
- 2. To be considered, a clear photo representing each category you are entering must be forwarded with your application and payment, even if you have exhibited before. They will be used in selecting artists and eliminating ineligible applicants. Be sure to include quality photos, as they could determine your acceptance. Photos will not be returned!
- No manufactured, plastic items, balloons, comic books, combustible materials or items that are <u>not</u> handmade.
- 4. Exhibitors may be asked to and should be prepared to demonstrate assembly of any item if there is a question as to whether the item is handcrafted.
- 5. The NC Blueberry Festival Association has sole discretion on acceptability of work and reserves the right to remove any items from exhibitor's booths.

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CANCELLATION POLICY: No refunds will be made for vendor cancellations after acceptance. In the event of the entire festival being cancelled, paid vendor fees will be honored the following year.

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USE OF EXHIBIT SPACE: Each exhibitor will be assigned a specific space. Your exhibit area must be staffed throughout the day by you. All crafters are required to cover their space with a tent. Tents must be adequately staked and/or anchored. Exhibitors are expected to keep their spaces in good order during the show hours. Displays must stay within the perimeters of your designated space. All boxes must be stored out of sight. **Smoking inside your tent or in close proximity to other vendors, especially food vendors, is not allowed.**

TAXES: Remember to get your North Carolina Sales Tax ID Number if you don't already have one. This can be obtained by filling out an NC-BR form or completing the form online. The website to the NC Department of Revenue is www.dornc.com. You can also call the NC Department of Revenue for information at 1-877-252-3052.

PARKING: You are not permitted to drive vehicles onto the lawn of the courthouse square. You will be allowed to temporarily park around the square to unload your materials in a timely manner. Please move vehicles and trailers as soon as you unload. There are designated vendor parking areas. Accepted exhibitors will receive information on locations to park vehicles and trailers after unloading.

THE BLUEBERRY PICKUP LANE AND PARKING ALONG WILMINGTON STREET IS ALSO TO REMAIN CLEAR. TOWING WILL BE ENFORCED.

Please be courteous! <u>UNLOAD AND MOVE YOUR VEHICLES - DO NOT SET-UP FIRST</u>. ALL VEHICLES MUST BE REMOVED FROM THE COURTHOUSE AND SURROUNDING STREETS BY 8:15AM ON SATURDAY.

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SECURITY: There will be heavy law enforcement presence during festival hours. There will also be private overnight security patrolling the festival grounds. However, management is **NOT** responsible for any losses or damages.

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INSURANCE: All vendors must provide proof of liability insurance, preferably in the form of a COI (Certificate of Insurance) for the event taking place June 14 th and 15 th with a minimum coverage of \$1,000,000. The policy must name Pender County (805 S Walker Street, Burgaw, NC 28425) AND NC Blueberry Festival (106 E Wilmington
Street, Burgaw, NC 28425) as additional insureds. This can be submitted after you are notified of acceptance. (Initial)
PETS & CHILDREN: NO PETS ARE ALLOWED ON THE FESTIVAL GROUNDS AT ANYTIME. CHILDREN OF EXHIBITIORS MUST BE SUPERVISED BY EXHIBITORS AT ALL TIMES. DO NOT ALLOW YOUR CHILDREN TO ROAM FESTIVAL GROUNDS WITHOUT SUPERVISION.

DAMAGE TO GROUNDS: Exhibitors will be charged for any damage to grounds or for clean-up necessitated by litter, painting, oil, grease, and/or excessive debris left in the exhibitor's space.

USE OF IMAGES: The NC Blueberry Festival Association reserves the right to use photographs and video taken of exhibitor, exhibitor's booth, and personnel. These images may be used to promote the festival. (Initial)
OVERNIGHT LODGING: Please note if you are travelling from more than an hour away, there are minimal lodging and hotel options available in Burgaw. Nearby options may be available in Wallace or Wilmington. Both locations are approximately 30 minutes from the festival grounds so please plan accordingly. We will have overnight parking available if you will be travelling in an RV/camper.

If items of this type are offered for sale, the NC Blueberry Festival Selection Committee reserves the right to ask you to remove them. Failure to do so could result in dismissal from the show.
