Please note that when selecting your "Major-Academic Program of Interest" select "On Campus" delivery method to see all of Presidio University majors. You can then view and select online course options when registering for specific courses.

Important Enrollment Information and Application FAQs

Application Fee Waived

The application fee of \$20.00 is waived until further notice.

E-mail Address

The e-mail address is required on your application. To be sure we can best serve you and provide you with the most up-to-date University information in the most expeditious manner we require that you provide us with your e-mail address.

Social Security Number (SSN) and Date of Birth

Presidio University requests your Social Security Number (SSN) and date of birth to help identify your record within the system and ensure that all of your data is matched together, including financial aid application information, if applicable. If you provide your SSN and Date of Birth, it will be used by school officials for positive identification, institutional research, and required state and federal reporting. It may also be used within the

system for purposes such as system consumer and alumni relations and to create summary data about system programs through data matches with other state agencies.

Program Start Dates

Make sure the program you are selecting starts on the semester for which you are applying. DO NOT APPLY FOR MORE THAN ONE PROGRAM. program of interest.

Note:

Presidio University will ask you to provide information that includes private information under state and federal law. You are not legally required to provide the information the University is requesting, however, the University may not be able to effectively process your application if you do not provide sufficient information. With some exceptions, unless you consent to further release of private information, access to this information will be limited to school officials, including faculty who have legitimate educational interests in the information. Under certain circumstances, federal and state laws authorize release of private information without your consent

- To other schools in which you seek or intend to enroll, or are enrolled, if you are first notified of the release
- To federal, state, or local officials for purposes of program compliance, audit, or evaluation
- As appropriate in connection with your application for, or receipt of, financial aid
- To your parents, if your parents claim you as a dependent student for tax purposes
- If the information is sought with a subpoena, court order, or otherwise permitted by other state of federal law, and
- To an organization in educational research or accrediting agency

Federal and State legislation requires that the contents of student files be open to review by the student. Application forms, high school transcripts, test dates, letters, and recommendations that are sent as part of any application for admission will be open to the student's review upon request.

Immunization

Virginia State Law (135 A.14) requires that all students born after 1956 who are enrolled in a public or private post-secondary school in Virginia be immunized against measles, mumps, and rubella. There are certain specific exemptions to this law as noted on the Immunization Form provided as part of the application for admission. All others must complete the attached Immunization Form. The information provided on the Immunization form will, by law, will be made available for review by the Virginia Department of Health and the local community health board.

Admissions Process

Presidio University is not able to process a change of status from a B visa to an F-1 visa. A potential student applicant currently in the U.S. on a B visa can apply to Presidio University, but you must return to your home country in order to apply for the F-1 visa and return on the F-1 visa.

If you are a prospective international student not living in the U.S. and want to complete an associate degree at Presidio University, and you do not have any university transfer credits, please complete the following steps.

A new international student can apply for fall and spring admission only. For important dates and information: view Academic Calendar

- 1. Online Application. Make sure to write down your Student ID created in this step you will need it for other forms as a student.
- 2. Provide Proof of English Language Proficiency We accept a completely 100% online test.
- 3. Submit academic records
 - a. High school/secondary school transcript
 - b. High school/secondary school diploma
 - c. We also accept IGCSE with 5 classes at the O level with a C grade or better

Eligibility:

- Admission: University graduation is not limited to the department but must have work experience. Proof of valid cumulative work seniority
- 2. Introduction to the background size of a position or former service company (with supporting documents related to the company's performance)
- 3. Specialist or university studies can be studied directly

- after a remedial credit.
- 4. Other supporting documents for review (e.g. professional certificates, professional qualifications, certificates of outstanding work achievements)

To be considered for admission to Presidio University, international applicants must:

- After high school and
- With a certificate of completion, you can enter a university in your home country or country of graduation

In addition:

Students who have completed the IGCSE or O-level examination have not yet met the admission requirements of Saint Paul University. The university needs further study, i.e. completing a two-year A-level course and taking at least three academic examinations, an IB diploma or other similar academic course.

Students in countries requiring military service after completing secondary education should not submit applications until they have fulfilled their obligations. Saint Paul University cannot postpone admission until later.

Students may be <u>required to meet additional</u> admission requirements (links are external) and to complete undergraduate applications in accordance with certain guidelines as required by the country or education system.

Language requirements

English is crucial to the success of Saint Paul University. You can demonstrate your proficiency by taking one of the following exams and getting the required scores:

- English as a Foreign Language Test (TOEFL) with a minimum score of 80 or higher (University of Sao Paulo 80 points)
- The International English Language Examination System (IELTS) has a minimum score of 6.5

Language test scores must be received at the Undergraduate Admissions Office within one month of the fall semester in which the student wishes to enroll. If the language test scores do not meet the standards, the student must sign a cut-off letter to ensure that the most basic language requirements of Presidio University are met during or before graduation, and if

the language test scores are not met, then the student voluntarily abandons the study.

Other ways for international students to meet language requirements include:

- English Language of Instruction (LOI) for more than 3 years
- The AP test scores 3, 4, or 5 for English language and composition, or English literature and composition
- 6 or 7 points on the English IB standard level exam (language A only)
- 5, 6 or 7 points on the IB Advanced English exam (language A only)

Application documents:

- (1.) 1 entry form
- (2.) 1 English diploma and 1 Transcript for English
- (3.) Passport photo 1 copy, 2 photos 2
- (4.) 1 copy of your resume, 1 copy of your autobiography, 1 letter of recommendation
- (5.) Admission fee
- (6.) Proof of work experience

Please provide clear scanned copies of original academic records (transcripts and diploma) from all previous high school/secondary schools attended. E-mail scans to international@saintpauls.edu. If the scans are not clear or if Saint Paul University requests the originals, you may be asked to mail in the original academic records or certified official copies.

Applicant that has been suspended or expelled for disciplinary reasons may be denied admission.

You will receive a letter about your admission status within 3 days of completion of the above steps and receipt of the required documents, along with additional admission instructions.

You can pay for express mailing of your I-20 by following these instructions. Presidio University will not mail the I-20 visa document using regular mail. You must pay for express mailing through eShipGlobal.

2 Apply for Financial Assistance

Applying for financial assistance is easier than you think and it's free!

- 1. First, like with an email or bank account, create your Federal Student Aid (FSA) ID.
- 2. Second, complete your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

NOTE: When completing your FAFSA, be sure to list Presidio University (FAFSA Code = 005533) so your information is automatically sent to our Financial Aid Office.

3 Determine Course Placement

Presidio University wants to be sure you succeed and complete your University goals. Getting off to a good start by succeeding in your first courses is especially important. We advise you on the best courses to take when you're getting started. All you have to do is submit one of these items:

- An official high school transcript that includes your GPA and class rank,
- Test scores from ACT, SAT or MCA

If you cannot provide these documents, you'll need to take the ACCUPLACER so we have information to accurately place you in your initial courses at Presidio University.

4 Register for Courses
