Dear Justice Frank:

We write to inform the Court concerning the timetable referenced in last week's status report. The City and The Alliance are confident that the enhanced educational informational efforts undertaken since Your Honor's issuance of the preliminary injunction is proceeding at pace and successfully. We, therefore, hope that at the earliest opportunity the Court will permit Respondents to proceed with an April 1, 2022 implementation date.

In consideration of certain regulatory requirements and practical considerations, to achieve an April 1st implementation, it is necessary to undertake certain data preparation and transfer functions. As previously explained, once the data preparation has begun, while the City would still be able to process individual choices regarding plans throughout the time periods set forth in the Court's Order, any effort to reverse the process would, in the literal sense, require shutdown of the City's payroll system and the work of hundreds of people each working hundreds of hours to manually transfer each retiree. Consequently, Respondents respectfully request that the conference now set for February 23rd, be advanced to the soonest possible date, if possible this coming week, and that the Court soon thereafter, if not from the bench, issue a final determination on the proceeding. Only through such a definitive, imminent, determination can the City and The Alliance move forward with an April 1st implementation date without risk to City operations and delays, which could be confusing, if not injurious, to retirees who may be anticipating the April 1st date.

We thank the Court for its attention to this matter.
