1 VISIBILITY

The OSCP is bringing the following to the provincial and interprofessional healthcare tables: an understanding of the role of Cardiovascular Perfusionists in Ontario, means for delivering quality and safe patient care, advocacy for the growing needs in perfusion education, advocacy for compensation equity, and advocacy for provincial perfusion benchmarking and data capture.



2 EDUCATION

Advocating for advancements in Perfusion education and improvements to educational resources. Furthering ECMO education for nursing, as dictated by Perfusion ECLS-specialists. Advocating for Critical Care to expand and improve access to ECLS care for all Ontario patients.

3 TRAINING

Providing leadership support through framework development such as: basic & advanced on-boarding training, timelines & expectation criteria for new hires & graduates, and generating skill-sets for experienced perfusionists.



4 STANDARDS & GUIDELINES

For the first time in Canadian Perfusion history, the Ontario Perfusionists have formally adopted and endorsed Standards and Guidelines for Ontario Perfusion Practice (2023).



5 STRATEGY

The OSCP is moving forward at a fast pace to encourage, nurture and promote the roles and interests of Perfusionists within the Province of Ontario. Through weekly Ontario Perfusion Leadership meetings and monthly open-Membership town-halls, the support and work of perfusionists in 2023 has been inspiring.
