Parking at Drop-Off



Now that we're a few weeks into the school year, we just wanted to remind parents that in the morning the area in the gravel lot closest to the school / bus parking area is for immediate drop-off of students only. If you are parking and walking your children down to the bus, please park your cars on the opposite side of the lot along the wooded area. Parking restrictions are only in effect during the morning drop-off.

A NEW Playground!

BIG thank you to the PAC Playground Committee that took on the advocacy campaign to get a new playground for our kids to play on while they're at Winslow. Because of the efforts of this group and Hazel Trembath Staff's advocacy, a new playground will be built with completion expected to be before the middle of November. **PLUS...** this playground is movable! So when Hazel Trembath is rebuilt and our students return to our community, this playground can come too! However, as playground moving costs are not covered by the fire insurance, nor are they typically paid for by school districts, the PAC may have to help pay for the cost of relocating the playground. Participating in PAC events such as Dine Out for Hazel and seasonal fundraisers can help raise money for this.
