



**SCOTDANCE BRITISH COLUMBIA -
MRS. ADELINE DUNCAN HIGHLAND DANCE SCHOLARSHIP**

APPLICATION FORM

The Mrs. Adeline Duncan Highland Dance Scholarship is open to any past or current competitive dancer who is or will be attending any post-graduate institution in the province of British Columbia in the year of the application. Proof of attendance (receipt for tuition) will be required by the successful applicant. PREVIOUS RECIPIENTS OF THIS SCHOLARSHIP INELIGIBLE TO APPLY.

Funding to the recipient would be provided at the end of the post-secondary institution's school term where the applicant attended. An interim transcript and receipt of tuition paid from the post-secondary institution to be sent to the Treasurer of ScotDance British Columbia scotdancebctre@gmail.com prior to funding released to the recipient.

In the event of extenuating circumstances, where the recipient was not able to attend either online or in-person classes due to a declaration from either the post-secondary institution of force majeure or from the World Health Organization, the recipient is required to contact the Treasurer for ScotDance British Columbia requesting a review to extend the scholarship funding for an additional year. If the recipient does not request a review within 3 months of either of these declarations, the recipient shall forfeit the award.

The Executive of SDBC shall make the sole determination whether to extend the award.
