1. How are sins forgiven?

1 John 2:1-2 (NIV) The Test of Knowing Christ

My dear children, I write this to you so that you will not sin. But if anybody does sin, we have an Advocate with the Father - Jesus Christ, the Righteous One. **He is the atoning sacrifice for our sins, and not for ours but also for the sins of the whole world.**

1 John 4:10 (NIV) This is love: not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son as the atoning sacrifice for our sins.

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

Romans 3:21-22 (NIV) Righteousness Through Faith

But now apart from the law the righteousness of God has been made known, to which the Law and the Prophets testify. **This righteousness is given through faith in Jesus Christ to all who believe.**

Romans 3:25-26 (NIV) God presented Christ as a sacrifice of atonement, through the shedding His blood - to be received by faith. He did this to demonstrate his righteousness, because in His forbearance He had left sins committed beforehand unpunished - He did it to demonstrate His righteousness at the present time, so as to be just and the One who justifies those who have faith in Jesus.

Hebrews 10:11-18 Christ's Death Perfects the Sanctified

And every priest stands ministering daily and offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. But this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God, from that time waiting till His enemies are made His footstool. For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified. But the Holy Spirit also witnesses to us; for after He had said before, "This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, says the Lord: I will put My laws into their hearts, and in their minds I will write them," then He adds, "Their sins and their lawless deeds I will remember no more." Now where there is remission of these, there is no longer an offering for sin.

2. Worship and pray?

Revelation 22:7-9 "Behold, I am coming quickly! Blessed is he who keeps the words of the prophecy of this book." Now I, John, saw and heard these things. And when I heard and saw, I fell down to worship before the feet of the angel who showed me these things. Then he said to me, "See that you do not do that. For I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren the prophets, and of those who keep the words of this book. Worship God."

1 Timothy 2:5 For there is one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus, who gave Himself a ransom for all (one mediator means... this means Mary or any patron saint have no part in righteousness, forgiveness of sin, or salvation). The Catholic priest believes in prayer to Mary, which separates you from God. It is idol worship, to pray to Mary, who only served God, as did the angel in Rev. 22:7-9.

Matthew 6:7 And when you pray, do not use vain repetitions as the heathen do. For they think that they will be heard for their many words. This verse is exactly why the rosary is in conflict with the Bible, and reciting repetitions of the model prayer.

Matthew 6:9 In this manner, therefore pray: (see The Model Prayer) i.e. God prefers to hear what is in your heart, not vain repetitions.... Use your own words.

John 17 (Jesus prays for Himself, Disciples and Believers, see QR on back)

3. Salvation

1 Peter 1:3-9 A Heavenly Inheritance, verse 9: receiving the end result of your faith-the salvation of your souls. (Go to the QR code to read it all.)

Galatians 1:3-5 Grace to you and peace from God the Father and our Lord Jesus Christ, who gave Himself for our sins, that He might deliver us from this present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father, to whom be glory forever and ever. Amen.

John 3:16 For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

Matthew 10:32 "Therefore whoever confesses Me before men, him I will also confess before My Father who is in Heaven."

John 3:3 Jesus answered and said to him, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God."

Acts 2:38 Then Peter said to them, "Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

John 1:12-13 Born Again- Yet to all who did receive Him, to those who believed in His name, He gave the right to become children of God- children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God.

Matthew 3:13-17 Jesus Baptized (see attached page QR code)

Romans 6:1-23 Dead to sin, alive to God (must read, see QR code)

1 Corinthians 6:12-20 Glorify God (Must read, see QR code)

Matthew 23:9 do not call anyone on earth "father," for you have one Father, and He is in Heaven.

Matthew 4:10 Then Jesus said to him, "Away with you, Satan! For it is written, worship the Lord your God, and Him only you shall serve."

Acts 2:38 Peter replied, "Repent and be baptized, every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of your sins.

Exodus 20:3 You shall have no other Gods before Me.

Exodus 20:4-6 "You shall not make for yourself a carved image-any likeness of anything that is in Heaven above, or that is in the earth beneath, or that is in the water under the earth; you shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the parents to the third and fourth generation of those who hate me, but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments.
