The red letter text are words that Jesus spoke and were recorded in the Bible.

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

(read it in the Bible, New Testament John 3;16)

Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me."

(Bible, New Testament John 14;6)

Jesus replied, "Very truly I tell you, no one can see the kingdom of God unless they are born again. (Bible, New Testament John 3;3)

Praise to God for a Living Hope

Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ! In his great mercy he has given us new birth into a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead, and into an inheritance that can never perish, spoil or fade. This inheritance is kept in heaven for you, who through faith are shielded by God's power until the coming of the salvation that is ready to be revealed in the last time. In all this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while you may have had to suffer grief in all kinds of trials. These have come so that the proven genuineness of your faith—of greater worth than gold, which perishes even though refined by fire—may result in praise, glory and honor when Jesus Christ is revealed. Though you have not seen him, you love him; and even though you do not see him now, you believe in him and are filled with an inexpressible and glorious joy, for you are receiving the end result of your faith, the salvation of your souls. (read for yourself in the Bible, 1 Peter 1, verse 3-9)

Warning of Unbelief

"He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God. And this is the condemnation, that the light has come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil. For everyone practicing evil hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed. (You can read this in John 3:18-20)

"Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life." (John 5:24)

But, beloved, do not forget this one thing, that with the Lord one day is as a thousand years, and a thousand years as one day. The Lord is not slack concerning His promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance. (2 Peter 3:8-9)

"And I say to you, My friends, do not be afraid of those who kill the body, and after that have no more that they can do. But I will show you whom you should fear: Fear Him who, after He has killed, has power to cast into hell; yes, I say to you, fear Him!

(Bible, New Testament - Luke 12;4-5)

What should you do now? Now that you believe, you should continue to read the Bible, find a church that follows the Bible (this means a church with a pastor that will teach directly from the Bible, during the Sunday message from God (His Word in the Bible).

Know that a church service is a time to give praise (that's why we is sing) to our God that loves us so much. Praise God that He sent His Son to die for us and by His grace, we are saved. You will meet nice people that are willing to help you along in your growth in knowing the Bible, in Bible study groups, fellowship and just sharing what they know.

"Therefore whoever confesses Me before men, him I will also confess before My Father who is in heaven. But whoever denies Me before men, him I will also deny before My Father who is in heaven. (Bible, New Testament, Matthew 10;32-33)

Since the children have flesh and blood, he too shared in their humanity so that by his death he might break the power of him who holds the power of death—that is, the devil. (Bible, New Testament - Hebrews 2;14)
