The Pope, bowing to the Pope, touching the Pope, he is just a man, chosen by men.
Prayers to Mary, patron saint, or any saint, prayers to dead people won't save you
Eating anything, that includes a eucharist, or the Lord's supper



John 3:16 **“For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.”**

John 14:6 Jesus said to him, **“I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.”**

Romans 10:9 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

John 5:24-26 Said: **“Most assuredly, I say to you, he who hears My word and believes in Him who sent Me has everlasting life, and shall not come into judgment, but has passed from death into life.”**

1 Peter 1:3-9 **Though now you do not see Him, yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory, receiving the end of your faith - the salvation of your souls.**

Read the Bible, it is the book of truth! You can know the truth, just read the Bible. God did not create religion, man did and many religions stray from the truth in the Bible.

Matthew 6:7 - **And when you pray, do not use vain repetitions as the heathen do. For they think that they will be heard for their many words.**

Matthew 23:9 **Do not call anyone on earth your father; for One is your Father, He who is in Heaven. And do not be called teachers; for One is your Teacher, the Christ. Some religions call the priest “father”, which is not according to God's Word.**

1 Corinthians 10:3-4 all ate the same spiritual food, and all drank the same spiritual drink. For they drank of that spiritual Rock that followed them, and that Rock was Christ.

Luke 22:19 **“This is My body which is given for you; do this in remembrance of Me.**
do this in remembrance of Me - remember my sacrifice, not consume “My flesh”

John 6:54-55 “Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day. For My flesh is food indeed, and My blood is drink indeed.”

Whoever eats My flesh - **has the Word in them**

Jesus became flesh in the body of Jesus Christ, - **His flesh is the Word**

and drinks My blood has eternal life - **When you believe in Him**

John 1:1, John 1:14, the Word was God and the Word became flesh

Flesh and blood is only consumed by pagan and devil worship, God is spiritual.

John 6:63-64 “It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life. But there are some of you who do not believe.”

The Spirit who gives life - (not flesh)

the flesh - profits nothing (neither our flesh or His flesh)

The words that I speak to you are spirit (spiritual - pagans deal in rewards for the flesh)

But there are some of you who do not believe - (believe in Jesus, spiritually connect)

John 6 Jesus is the “bread of life”, Jesus is talking about knowing and believing in Him

The purpose of the Lord’s supper, is to **remember the sacrifice that Jesus made**. Not to physically eat His flesh, or drink His blood.

John 4:23-24 “But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.”

This He said to the woman at the well, read John 4, God is real, but our relationship with Him is all spiritual (because Jesus is sitting at the right hand of the Father.

1 Corinthians 11:24-25 and when He had given thanks, He broke it and said, “Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in **remembrance of Me**.” In the same manner He also took the cup after supper, saying, “This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in **remembrance of Me**.”

in remembrance of Me - God wants us, **to remember, He died for us**

1 Corinthians 5:8 We are confident, yes, well pleased rather to be absent from the body and to be present with the Lord. There is no purgatory, but two resurrections, either life or death.

1 Corinthians 15:44 It is sown a natural body, it is raised a spiritual body.

1 Corinthians 15:50 Now this I say, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God (if you go to Heaven, it will be your soul, not your flesh!)

John 5:29 those who have done good, to the resurrection of life, and those who have done evil, to the resurrection of condemnation. John 3:18 he who does not believe is condemned already
