SJPHC Fall Color Challenge & Youth Scholarship Circuit

Show Rules & Regulations:

- APHA Rules to apply to all classes
- Exhibitors must present a current APHA membership ID
- Exhibitors in Youth or Amateur classes must present a current APHA Amateur, Novice Amateur, Youth or Novice Youth number at time of registration
- Exhibitor must be able to prove ownership at the time of show by presenting the APHA Registration Certificate or a legible photocopy with the correct owner or owner's name. Rules regarding the eligibility of exhibitors with leased horses will follow the APHA rules outlined in the current APHA Rule Book
- Management will strictly enforce the APHA rules of conduct. Show management may immediately expel offenders from show grounds or show facilities.
- Show ground rules must be adhered to at all times.
 Watch for parking restrictions. No announcements will be made regarding parking violators.
- All dogs must be on leashes at all times
- SJPHC cannot be held liable for any towed vehicles, trailers or impounded animals.
- PAC Credits: Horses currently enrolled in the APHA PAC Program are eligible to earn PAC credits in All Breed classes

Eligibility Rules:

<u>AWARDS:</u> Champion & Reserve Awards will be given. All APHA horses are eligible for all awards unless specifically stated otherwise in the awards rules.

POINTS: Points for Amateur & Youth Awards will be awarded on the basis of one horse/one exhibitor. For all other awards, points will be awarded to the horse not the exhibitor. Green class points count only for the Green Horse Award. Color Class points count only for Color Class Awards.

WALK-JOG EXHIBITOR ELIGIBILITY: Exhibitor must not compete in a lope class at this show & must present a Novice Amateur or Youth card from a recognized Association in all performance classes where points may be earned OR present an APHA Amateur Walk-Trot Division Card.

PERFORMANCE HALTER ELIGIBILITY: A horse is eligible only if the horse competes in a performance class at this show. For the purpose of Performance Halter eligibility, showmanship does not count as a performance class. Refer to APHA Rulebook for more.

ALL BREED ELIGIBILITY: Open to any breed. Points awarded to the horse, not the exhibitor/horse team. Can cross enter into any class if eligible. Must compete in at least 2 All Breed Classes. ALL halter points that the horse is eligible to earn count towards this award.

Awards:

<u>COLOR CLASS CHAMPION:</u> Points from Youth, Amateur & Open Tobiano and Overo Color Classes will count toward this award. Color Class points will NOT count towards any other award.

HALTER MARE & STALLION/GELDING CHAMPIONS:

Points earned in APHA Youth, Amateur, and Open Halter count. Additional points awarded for Grand/Reserve as outlined in SC-065 in the APHA Rule Book.

YOUTH WALK/JOG 5-10 & 11-18 CHAMPION: To be eligible for this award, a horse/exhibitor team must compete in at least 2 Walk/Jog 5-10 or 11-18 classes. Youth halter points count.

NOVICE YOUTH & NOVICE AMATEUR CHAMPIONS: All points earned in Novice classes count. An exhibitor must compete in at least 2 Novice performance classes to qualify. Points earned in an exhibitor's age group do not count. ALL halter points that horse/exhibitor earn count.

YOUTH & AMATEUR CHAMPIONS: All points earned in exhibitor's age group count (13&U, 18&U, Amateur). An exhibitor must compete in at least 2 age group performance classes to qualify. ALL halter points that horse/exhibitor earn count.

APHA AMATEUR WALK-TROT CHAMPION: Points earned in all APHA Amateur Walk-Trot classes count toward this award. At least 2 performance classes are required to earn this award. ALL halter points that horse/exhibitor earn count.

YEARLING VERSATILITY: Highest point earning Yearling that shows in all three: Yearling Halter, In-Hand Trail, and Longe Line. ALL halter points that horse earns count.

GREEN HORSE CHAMPION: All APHA Green Horse classes count toward this award. At least 2 Green classes are required to earn an award. ALL halter points that horse earns count.

NEW! ALL-BREED 1st Yr GREEN HORSE CHAMPION: Only All-Breed 1st Yr Green Horse classes 100, 146, 322 count toward this award. At least 2 of the 3 All-Breed 1st Yr Green classes are required to earn this award. NO halter points count.

<u>OPEN JR/SR HORSE CHAMPIONS:</u> All points earned in Open performance classes count. Points are awarded to the horse regardless of exhibitor. Must compete in at least 2 performance classes. ALL halter points that horse earns count.

ALL BREED CHAMPION: Points earned in respective All Breed classes except 1st Yr Green count toward this Award. An exhibitor must compete in at least 2 All Breed performance classes to qualify. ALL halter points that horse/exhibitor earn count

HIGH POINT WRHA RANCH HORSE: See Rulebook for Ranch horse eligibility. Award sponsored by WRHA. Must be a WRHA Member and compete in at least 2 Ranch performance classes. NO halter points count.

Jackpot Payment Information

Money earned will be paid by check and mailed to the person who paid the entry fee within 30 days of show completion.

If recipients have monies due to the show (including SJPHC), jackpot checks will be held until debts are paid in full. If the debts are not paid within 15 days of the jackpot class, all money due to the recipient is forfeited.

Jackpot checks will be valid for 90 days from the date they are written. Any checks not negotiated within 90 days will be voided.
