<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• APHA Rules to apply to all classes</li> <li>• Exhibitors must present a current APHA membership ID</li> <li>• Exhibitors in Youth or Amateur classes must present a current APHA Amateur, Novice Amateur, Youth or Novice Youth number at time of registration</li> <li>• Exhibitor must be able to prove ownership at the time of show by presenting the APHA Registration Certificate or a legible photocopy with the correct owner or owner's name. For all other awards, points will be awarded to the horse not the exhibitor. Green class points count only for the Green Horse Award. Color Class points will NOT count towards any other award.</p> <p><b><u>HALTER MARE &amp; STALLION/GELDING CHAMPIONS:</u></b> Points earned in APHA Youth, Amateur, and Open Halter count. ### Jackpot Payment Information

Money earned will be paid by check and mailed to the person who paid the entry fee within 30 days of show completion.
