Secretary's Report – September notes were read. Louis motioned to accept report, Dave second. Approved

Treasurers Report –Balances: Checking: \$3,609.55, Youth \$1500.98. Matt motioned to accept report, Tom second. Approved

Old Business:

- 6 New bales arrived, we install right before regionals. We will sell old bales for \$75 per bale.
- 3D targets/inserts- need to at least order inserts. Will inventory targets in trailer in spring or if we pull targets out for youth day.
- Open house is set for Dec 7th from 4-8PM, Board members will provide snack. Will need to print out membership sheets prior, Zach has the new forms updated with increased pricing.
- Discussed leagues and league runners. Louis will do Traditional, Brent will do Vegas, Matt will do paper animal and Genesis league. We need someone to run 300 and 360 league.
- Youth fun shoot – Will be December 2nd from 12-3pm. Will have food, kids 12 and under eat free, otherwise \$5 per meal. The club will buy hotdogs and buns, Matt will contact subway on chips and cookies.
- Will look into having range sponsorship – The business will get a 2'X3' banner hung up in range, \$100 to make the banner. Pricing will be \$150 for 1 year, \$350 for 3 year, and \$500 for 5 year. The price includes the cost of the banner and businesses will get a 501C3 donation form.

New Business:

- Working with the city on getting new signs at outdoor range about no crossbows. The city also will post changes on the city park and rec website.

- Outdoor range takedown – will monitor weather and will send out a text to board members when the targets will be taken down.
- Range lease contract – The current contract is a 10 year contract and goes until December 2029.
- Have had request to have 1 lane at indoor range for crossbows since they are now legal for archery season. Board voted no due to the power and it will damage bales, and it could also violate our insurance policy.
- LCAC had a 2023 MSAA Grand Champion, congrats to Tom Mack!
- Trailer storage – The fairgrounds will charge \$360 to store trailer inside for winter, have paid in past years also. Matt motioned to approve payment, Louis second.
