

I. IMPORTANT SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

1. When using an electrical mechanism, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following: Read all instructions before using.



WARNING – To reduce the risk of burns, fire, electric shock, or injury to persons:

- 1. The main power switch is marked with international symbols "O" and "I". The switch in position "I" means that system is on, and the switch in position "O" means that system is off.
- 2. The chair should never be left unattended when plugged in. Unplug from outlet when not in use and before putting on or taking off parts.
- 3. Do not wear shoes, jewelry, glasses, or watches of any kind.
- 4. Close supervision is necessary when this chair is used near children, invalids, or disabled persons. Keep children away from extended foot support (or other similarparts).
- 5. Use the chair only for its intended use as described in this manual. Do not use attachments not recommended by the manufacturer.
- 6. Never operate the chair if it has a damaged cord or plug, if it is not working properly, if it has been dropped, damaged, or dropped into water. Return the chair to an authorized service center for examination and repair.
- 7. Keep the cord away from heated surfaces.
- 8. Do not use outdoors.
- 9. Do not operate where aerosol (spray) products are being used or where oxygen is being administered.
- 10. To disconnect, turn power switch to the off position, then remove plug from outlet.
- 11. Connect this chair to a properly grounded outlet only. See Grounding Instructions.
- Do not remove the back cushion and do not play with roller mechanism.
- 13. Do not remove the bottom seat and do not play with actuators.
- 14. Keep the cord out of heavy traffic areas. To avoid fire hazard, NEVER put the cord under rugs or near heat generating devices.
- 15. Always unplug the power cord from the electrical outlet before cleaning.
- 16. Do not operate any chair with damaged parts.

- 17. Any other use not recommended by the manufacture may cause electrical shock or injury to persons.
- 18. Do not touch or re-wire the connectors to the master-box.
- 19. Do not attempt to repair or adjust any electrical or mechanical functions on this unit. Doing so will void the warranty.

2. Grounding Instructions

This product must be grounded. If there is a malfunction or breakdown, the grounding provides a path of least resistance for electric current to flow, thus reducing the risk of electric shock. This product is equipped with a cord having an equipment-grounding conductor and a grounding plug. The plug must be plugged into an appropriate outlet that is properly grounded in accordance with all local codes and ordinances.

DANGER - Improper connection of the equipment-grounding conductor can result in a risk of electric shock. Check with a qualified electrician or serviceman if you are in doubt as to whether the product is properly grounded. Do not modify the plug provided with the product, if it does not fit the outlet; have a proper outlet installed by a qualified electrician.

Followed by either instruction a) or b) below:




Fig.1: Grounding Instruction

- a) This product is for use on a normal power circuit and has a grounding plug that looks like the plug illustrated in sketch A in Figure 1 below. A temporary adapter that looks like the adapter illustrated in sketches B and C may be used to connect this plug to a 2-pole receptacle as shown in sketch B if a properly grounded outlet is not available. The temporary adapter should be used only until a properly grounded outlet (sketch A) can be installed by a qualified electrician. The green colored rigid ear, lug, or the like extending from the adapter must be connected to a permanent ground such as a properly grounded outlet box cover. Whenever the adapter is used, it must be held in place by a metal screw.
- b) This product is for use on a normal power circuit and has a grounding plug that looks like the plug illustrated in sketch A in Figure 1 below. Make sure that the product is connected to an outlet having the same configuration as the plug. No adapter should be used with this product.

MEDICAL WARNINGS - NOT RECOMMENDED FOR:

- Pregnant women
- People with distorted joints, broken bones, skin infection or injury
- Children under 14 years of age

If you have any of the above medical issues or anyother concerns, please consult your doctor before using the massage chair.



DO NOT:

- Allow children or pets to play near the chair, especially during operation.
- Use any massage function on the head.
- Massage abdominal area or kneecap region.
- Leave mobility impaired or speech impaired persons alone in chair.
- Wear shoes, jewelry, glasses, or watches of any kind.



EMERGENCY STOP

In case of emergency, press the stop button on the remote to stop the operation.

Additional Safety Precautions

- Do not use more than 30 minutes per session.
- Do not operate near young children or pets.
- Do not move the machine during operation.
- Do not place or store the chair near damp places such as swimming pools or bathrooms.
- Do not forcibly press on the massage rollers.
- Do not stand on the chair or store heavy items on the chair.
- Do not use in an environment which is dusty, greasy or lacking oxygen.
- Do not place near steam, oven, open fire, or heat.
- Do not place directly in the sun.
- Do not use electric blanket while using the massage chair.
- Do not use outdoors.
- Do not use while smoking.
- Do not eat or drink in chair when operating.
- Do place this chair horizontally with space over 81inches, enough for full recline mode.
- Do place on level floor.
- Do wear suitable clothing at all times while using.
- This chair has a heating option. People sensitive to heat must be careful when operating the chair when the heat option is on.

<u>Note:</u> Do not use the chair as a bed or to sleep on over a long period of time. The recommended time of use is 20 minutes. Prolonged massaging may cause aches, muscle or nerve issues. (The preferred total duration of massaging within the day should be 30 minutes total or less).



CAUTION FOR USERS

- This device should not be used until grounded.
- <u>Do not sit</u> or <u>place heavy objects</u> on the armrest, footrest or back of the chair to avoid overturning or damaging the chair.
- In the course of normal use, lift the back cushion regularly to check for any damage or cracks in the fabric of the cushion. Please stop using immediately even if there is minor damage and turn the power switch off. Send the cushion in for repair to avoid possible electric shock.
- Do not move the chair while in use.

- Do not pull the fabric forcefully or stab it with sharp objects which can result in injury or damage to the chair.
- Do not move the chair on wooden floor, carpet, or other easily damaged flooring.
- Children and pets should not be allowed to play around chair.
- Please be sure that no people, pets, or other objects are behind the chair or under the legs before reclining or lowering the leg massager.
- Do not put your hands or head under the chair.
- When using the massage chair, ascertain that the footrest is in the lowest position.
- Do not use immediately after meals.
- Do not use the massage chair when your body is wet or moist as it can result in electrical shock.
- Do not operate with more than one person.
- Do not use when wearing head ornamentation as it can result in injury.
- Do not stumble over electrical wires or connections
- Do not touch the inner parts of the chair as this cancause damage and electrical shock.
- Do not dismantle and remove inner parts, or repair the massage chair.

Do Not Use the Chair under the Following Conditions

- When the chair has been exposed to water or fails to operate.
- If power cable is damaged.
- Please stop using the massage chair immediately and consult a doctor if you feel abnormal or extremely achy during the course of the massage.
- If a power failure occurs.
- When the massage chair malfunctions during the course of operation.
- Do not operate during a lightening or thunderstorms.

Methods of Storage

- Do not dismantle the back of the chair.
- Keep the massage chair free of dust.
- Cover the chair with dust-free cloth to prevent dust from collecting.
- Do not store in a hot, humid, damp place nor in direct sunlightor heat.

Cleaning Methods

- Before cleaning unplug from electrical source to avoid shock.
- Clean the chair surface with mild cleanser.
- Use leather cleaner and leather conditioner.
- Dust can be cleaned off with a damp cloth using mild cleanser and let air dry.
- Do not spray pesticides on the device.
- Do not use a damp cloth on the electronic components, as it may cause shock and damage

Chair Placement

There must be enough space around the chair for proper operation. There should be a clearance of 36 inches from the front of the chair to the wall, 24 inches from the wall to the backrest, and 18 inches from the wall to the closest armrest to allow for easy access.

II. INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

<u>ATTENTION:</u> Do not turn on power until all installation is complete. For more detailed instructions, please watch the i9 Max Series "how to install" videos at <u>www.luracochairs.com</u>

Step 1: Unpack the main box

Carefully take out the chair main body, footrest, armrests, and remote control packages from the main box.

<u>Note</u>: i9 Max Series chair requires at least two people to assist with assembly.





ATTENTION

Be sure no children, pets, or objects are around chair. Allow enough space for installation.

Step 2: Assemble the Footrest




Fig.3: Footrest Assembly

Please refer to Fig. (3-6) and follow the steps (1-6) below to install the Footrest.

- Install the Footrest hinges. Slowly align the footrest with the chair main body and install the lock-pins (2pcs) for the footrest hinges (Fig.3, Step 1)






Fig.4: Footrest Assembly

- Lift the Footrest to give space for further installation steps (Fig.4, Step 2)
- Insert the empty Footrest box underneath the footrest to support it. (Fig.4, Step 3)
- Insert all cables and air tubes through the aperture in the chair front cover (Fig.4, Step 4)
- 5. Pull and Lift the chair Front cover up to give room for next step. (Fig.4, Step 5)
- 6. Assemble the electrical connectors (4pcs). Make sure the color marks/numbers are matched, and connectors are locked by tightening the locking nuts (Fig.5, Step 6).
- 7. Assemble air connectors (5pcs). Make sure the color marks/numbers are matched (Fig.5, Step 7).




Fig.6: Footrest Assembly: Chair Front Cover Reset

- Put back the chair front cover. Make sure left and right edges of the front cover are properly inserted in to the guiding rails (Fig. 6, Step 8).

Fig.5: Instruction for Footrest Air tubes and Cables Assembly

Step 3: Assemble the Armrests





Fig.7: Armrest Installation

Please refer to Fig. (7-8) and follow the steps (1-5) below to install the armrests.

- 1. Insert the metal tab on the armrest into the located slot on the chair frame (Fig. 7, Step 1).
- 2. Install 2 knob-screws to secure the armrest metal plate onto the seat frame (Fig. 7, Steps 2).
- 3. Assemble armrest air connectors (2 pcs). Make sure the color marks/numbers are matched (Fig. 8, Step 3).
- 4. Assemble electrical connectors (2 pcs). Make sure the color marks/numbers are matched and connectors are locked by tightening the locking nut (Fig. 8, Step 4).
- 5. Repeat steps (1 thru 4) above for the second armrest assembly.

NOTE: For i9 Max Special, Billionaire, Royal Editions Only, one USB connector needs to be connected for the wireless phone charger on the Left Armrest (Fig. 8, Step 5).

Step 4: Remote Control Installation




Fig.9: Remote Panel (Located on the back of the chair)

Please refer to Fig. (9-10) and follow the steps (1-4) below to install the Remote




Fig.10: Remote Controller Installation

- 1. Insert the Remote into the leather pouch on the right Armrest (Fig.10, Step 1)
- 2. Insert the Remote cable through the leather loop on the Armrest (Fig.10, Step 2)
- 3. Install the remote connector (Make sure to secure 2 locking screws

- on both sides of connector). (Fig. 10, Step 3)
- 4. Install the Remote cable clamp (Fig. 10, Step 4).

 Note: This Cable Clamp must be installed to prevent data communication failures during operation.

ATTENTION! BEFORE TURNING POWER ON

- 1. Be sure there are no objects behind the chair before reclining.
- 2. Be sure power cord is plugged into the chair power inlet.
- 3. Power is turned on/off by a switch near power inlet (Switch to position "I" to turn on and position "0" to turn off).
- 4. Use the remote to choose the massage functions.

III. UNDERSTANDING THE CONTROL FEATURES

1. Quick Instructions for Main Screen

Auto:

Allows user to select one of the 9 automatic massage programs.

• Manual:

Allows user to customize a massage profile that best fits the body needs for optimal results. After an optimized profile is created, user can save it under "Users Profile". User can then recall the saved profile next time chair is used.

Settings:

Allows user to setup system preferences and passcode protection.

Info:

Displays health information related to the human body acupressure and reflexology points. It's designed to help the user understand and customize a massage profile that is best suited for them.

Heat:

Allows user to turn on/off the heat and to adjust the heat level.

Adjust:

Allows user to adjust the chair to their preferred position and chair parameters. The chair position and parameters will be stored in user profile when saved.

Pause/Play:

Allows user to Pause and Resume a massage cycle.

• Intensity:

Unlike many other chairs on the market, the i9 Max Series give the user control of the massage intensity for different parts of your body. Intensity levels are also stored in user profile when saved.

Users:

Allows user to save customized massage profiles, chair position, and intensity levels.

2. Start/Stop Button

Starts and stops the massage chair. The default timer for each massage session is 20 minutes. Pressing this button a second time will put the chair back to its initial position automatically. When time is up, if the sleep setting is checked, the chair maintains its position to avoid sleep disruption.

3. Automatic Massage Modes

Health Mode:

Specifically designed for health enhancement that mainly focuses on health aspects like releasing muscle strain, improving blood flow,

soothing anxiety and helps to relieve depression. This mode is the default massage mode when you start the chair. Heat therapy is automatically turned on in this mode.

• Soft Mode:

Applies a VERY soft, mainly air massage throughout the body. This mode is good for a relaxed and comfortable feeling for people that haven't used a massage chair before.

Demo Mode:

Provides a quick full body massage. It combines the best features of all massage modes. It allows user to experience a bit of everything in a short cycle. Heat therapy is automatically turned on in this mode.

Morning Mode:

Designed specifically for morning use, focusing on energizing the body by providing stretching, mobilizing joints and promoting flexibility with some muscle exercise.

Night Mode:

Designed specifically for evening/night use to enhance sleep, focusing on relieving postural stress after a day's work. It also helps relieve anxiety, depression and headaches.

Sport Mode:

Geared towards people involved in sporting activities to help prevent or treat injuries. It focuses on areas of the body that are overused and stressed from repetitive and aggressive movements. It promotes flexibility, reduces fatigue, improves endurance, and reduces muscle soreness. This mode provides a high intensity massage program with more focus on the hands and feet.

· Shiatsu Mode:

Provides a high intensity and point based massage with varied and rhythmic pressure on different parts of the body. It helps relieve severe tension in muscles and connecting tissues, relieves blockages and rejuvenates the body.

Stretch Mode:

Focuses on stretching and promotes mobility throughout the body. It stretches muscles, enhances muscular coordination, helps improve posture/flexibility and provides a greater sense of well-being.

TV/Recliner Mode:

Puts the chair into a comfortable position for watching TV or reading. This allows the user to adjust the chair to preferred position. Timer is off in this mode.

4. Manual Massage Modes

The i9 Max Series allows the user to easily customize the massage profile and save them under 5 different user profiles. Touch a button on the body diagram screen to **add or remove** the massage for specific parts of the body. For back massage, first select a back area, then press more for massage options. The selected massage profiles will be highlighted in a blue color on the buttons. (Fig.12-13)

Bluetooth Music Streaming from a Smartphone

The iRobotics 9 Max Series use an integrated, high-quality and high-power (10 Watts) speaker system using the latest Bluetooth technology for music streaming.

<u>Note:</u> Depending on the phone and BT chip version, a password maybe prompted. Default Password/PIN is: 4321

Connecting to the Luraco Bluetooth speakers is just like connecting to any other Bluetooth device in your home.

Please refer to your smartphone Manufacturer's Handbook for guidelines but generally speaking, these are the steps to be followed:

On your Smartphone, Tablet or Laptop (that has the Bluetooth feature):

- 1. Go to Bluetooth setting
- Select Search for available devices
- 3. Select "<u>Luraco BT Music</u>" and pair. If "<u>Luraco BT Music</u>" is not visible on the phone, reboot the chair and/or the phone. Also, make sure the Bluetooth Speaker is turned on from the remote Settings.
- Play whatever you want on your Smartphone, Tablet or Laptop
- 5. Listen, relax and enjoy

<u>Note:</u> When Bluetooth is connected, the chair's voice response features will be muted. Disconnecting or turning off Bluetooth on your music playing device will resume the chair's voice response features automatically.

6. Heat On/Off and Intensity Settings

This screen allows the user to turn heat function on/off and control intensity level.

There are <u>5</u> heat levels with 1 being the lowest and 5 being the warmest. Simply touch <u>HEAT</u> to start this feature except for the Health, Demo, and Shiatsu Modes where heat turns on automatically.

7. Chair Adjustments

This screen allows the user to adjust the chair positions and finetune some performance parameters to their preferences. The chair position will also be stored under "User Profile" when saved. (Fig.18).

8. Intensity Adjustments

This screen allows the user to manually adjust intensity settings for 6 different zones of the body.

9. User Profiles

How to Save a User Profile:

After chair adjustments have been made, hit **Users** -> **Save** -> Enter name of new user -> press **ENTER** -> press **DONE**, the "**successfully saved**" message appears. Up to 5 unique users can be saved. During body scan, the save button is greyed out.

How to Open a Saved User Profile:

When returning to your chair you can bypass the body scan by going to "USER', then 'OPEN" and clicking on the previously savedprofile. Chair will return to the last saved settings. Only saved profiles will show.

Settings can be changed by making the adjustments desired and then hitting the 'SAVE' button again.

If wrong profile is chosen, select "Cancel", choose the correct profile and then "OK".




Fig.23: Customized Remote Screens

IV. How to Use I9's Unique Features

1. Powered Armrest Open/Close for Easy Access




Fig.24: Armrest Open and Close for Easy Side Access

ATTENTION: NEVER SIT ON ARMRESTS OR LEGRESTS!

To open/close the Armrest, simply press the button on the Armrest (**Fig.24**). The Armrest can also be controlled from the Remote under the **Adjust** Screen (**Fig.19**). Door Safety Alarm can be turned off from the same screen.

2. Shoulder Massager Position Adjusts




Fig.25: Bicep/Shoulder Massager Position Adjustment

3. Some Helpful Tips When Using i9 Series Medical Massage Chairs

- Sit back and relax with your head resting against the backrest for body scan and shoulder detection. During the body scan process, please do not operate the Remote control.
- 2. For a more accurate body scan, move the pillow up or flip it to the back.
- 3. If you prefer a stronger neck massage, please flip the pillow to the back.
- 4. Footrest extension sensor is located below the right heel. Pressing on this sensor will extend the footrest. For accurate measurement, please place your heel all the way in.
- 5. If you want to skip the body scan and get directly to a massage, you should first save a user profile and open it.
- 6. Luraco i9 Series implements a high-speed processor and advanced embedded operating system (OS) and complex software applications. Thus, it requires system reboot sometimes for software to reset and sensors and electronics to be reinitialized. We recommend a chair reboot whenever you feel a chair reset is needed.

4. Health Benefits of Massage

Massage is the manipulation of superficial layers of muscle and connective tissue to enhance function and promote relaxation and wellbeing. Peer-reviewed medical research has shown that the benefits of massage include pain relief, reduced anxiety and depression, and temporarily reduces blood pressure, heart rate, and state of anxiety.

- Pain and stress relief: Relief from pain due to muscle-related injuries and other causes is cited as a major benefit of massage. In one study, cancer patients self-reported symptomatic relief of pain. Acupressure or pressure point massage could be beneficial in relieving back pain.
- State of anxiety: Massage has been shown to reduce a state of anxiety.
- Depression: Massage has been shown to reduce sub-clinical depression.
- Blood pressure and heart rate: Massage has been shown to reduce blood pressure and heart rate as temporary effects.
- **Sleep better:** Massage has been shown to help improve deep sleep at night.

V. HEALTH CARE DEVICE (BLOOD PRESSURE MONITOR)

The iRobotics 9 Max Series Medical Massage Chair has the capability to operate an optional health monitoring device. The device measures blood pressure and heart rate of the user. Connect the blood pressure monitor to blood pressure port on the side panel of the chair to charge the device before operating (**Refer to Fig.9**).

This device is an optional product but is included with the i9 Max Special Edition, Billionaire Edition, and Royal Edition.

VI. TROUBLESHOOTING THE MASSAGE CHAIR

WARNING: Unplug the power cord before attempting any troubleshooting or service.

The chair has different LED indicators, which help the user to narrow down a troubleshooting failure, if any.
