

ATTENTION

This product contains a rechargeable Lithium-ion battery pack. Lithium-ion batteries have a much longer life and a higher capacity compared to regular NiCad batteries. However, care must be taken when storing and using Lithium-ion batteries and all products containing Lithium-ion batteries. For prolonged storage periods, a temperature of around 25°C or below 80°F is recommended. In addition, the batteries should be stored at a charged level of around 60% of capacity. Always keep battery and drill controller away from wet and/or heated surfaces.

Over-discharging Lithium-ion batteries will result in permanent battery damage. If you need to stock LabPro units for a prolonged period of time, we recommend that the LabPro controller be charged at least once every 6 months to prevent permanent damage to the Lithium-ion battery pack.

When using electrical equipment, basic safety precautions should always be followed to reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock or injury.


- Read and follow all instructions before using the equipment. This equipment should not be used by children.
- 2. Use only with the LabPro handpiece!
- Do not disassemble or modify the unit without authorization from Luraco Health & Beauty, LLC. Warranty will be voided if changes are made without authorization.
- 4. Keep power cord and controller away from wet or hot surfaces.
- 5. Lock the chuck before using the handpiece to avoid product malfunction.
- 6. Do not touch the handpiece connector with wet hands.
- 7. Make sure the handpiece has completely stopped before putting it down.

- 8. Always turn off and unplug power to the equipment before servicing.
- Do not insert any object into any openings and avoid dropping the equipment. In the event of the handpiece being dropped, check to make sure the bit is not bent and the unit does not overheat.
- 10. Never operate this equipment with a damaged cord or plug. If it is not working properly, if it is dropped or damaged, or dropped into water, return the equipment to a service center for examination and repair.
- 11. Wear proper protective clothes and equipment, including a dust mask and safety goggles. Keep the workplace clean.

III. OPERATIONS

3.1. Understanding the Handpiece controller



The Side and Front View of Handpiece Controller


1	Power Connector	When the power cord is plugged in, the unit will charge automatically. Use only with Luraco 11.5V Charger.	
2	Handpiece Controller	The drill controller is the heart of the system and houses the control electronics and the battery.	
Charge LED		Blue light indicates the controller is being charged.	
3	Indicator	Off - The unit is not receiving external power.	
4 Power S Speed C	Power Switch &	Turn the knob clockwise to turn on the unit and increase the speed. Turn the knob counterclockwise to decrease the speed.	
	Speed Control	Turn the knob counter-clockwise to the end to turn off the unit.	
5	Battery LED	Green – Battery is good.	
		Flashing Green – Automatic shut down in 15 minutes.	
		Flashing red and green – Controller shuts down due to drill overload current.	
	Indicator	Flashing red – Battery is almost depleted.	
		Solid red – Battery is severely depleted and must be recharged.	
	Handpiece Direction Switch	Up (Forward) the spindle will rotate in the forward direction.	
6		Down (Reverse) the spindle will rotate in the reverse direction.	
7	Handpiece Connector	Where the handpiece connects/disconnects. Use only with the Luraco LabPro handpiece	
8	Base Stand	Magnetic base stand for controller and handpiece

3.4. Changing The Drill Bit

Step 1) Release the drill bit by turning the lock clockwise so that the dot is aligned with the symbol as shown below.



Step 2) Change the drill bit.

Step 3) **Lock** the handpiece bit by turning the lock counterclockwise so that the dot is aligned with the symbol **a** as shown below.





- To avoid product malfunction, always lock the handpiece chuck/lock before using.
- Always check the bit for any damages.

3.5 Battery Management System

Luraco LabPro has an onboard battery monitoring system that will monitor the Lithiumion battery while the drill is in operation. In the event that the battery is completely depleted, simply plug the power cord into the power connector on the control unit and continue your work. It charges automatically while in use.

Battery Indicator Status				
Green Light	The battery is in the optimal range			
Flashing Green	Flashing Green – Automatic shut down in 15 minutes.			
Flashing Red	The battery is running low and will only provide about 1 more hour of use			
Solid Red Light	The battery is critically low and should be recharged immediately			
Flashing Red and Green Light	Controller shuts down due to drill overload current			

3.6 Troubleshooting Guide

Issues	Troubleshooting	Diagnosis/Solution
Handpiece does not work	Connect to the charger	Working now: Battery was low
		Not working: Check the controller or handpiece
No charging blue light when connected to the charger	Verify that the charger is plugged in properly	Make sure to use only the Luraco 11.5V charger
Battery low warning comes on too often	Let the unit charge overnight	The battery is approaching its end of life. Call Luraco Customer Service to purchase a replacement battery

3.7 Product Maintenance

- Keep the area around the handpiece clean from dust and grindings.
- Remove dust on handpiece, wiping with isopropyl alcohol and avoid all liquids from penetrating into internal parts.
- Do not clean with water.
- <u>Do not apply oil</u> to the product. The grease inside the bearing could melt due to oil.
- Air cleaning is acceptable but do not use high air pressure.

- 2. This Warranty applies only to the repair or replacement of any supplied or manufactured parts of this product. **The warranty does not cover dropped or abused units**, wrong installations, inappropriate maintenance or repairs, and normal wear and tear of bearings, spindle, gear, and rotator.

The following conditions may void the warranty

- Dropping or excessive shock to the handpiece or control box
