NRA Basic Pistol - Blended Beginner	This is a combination of online learning for the classroom portion and hands-on learning at the range with an instructor. The online portion is completed on your schedule. When done, the range time is scheduled.	None – this class is designed for those with zero gun experience or knowledge.	Proper clothing for the range.	Online portion is at your leisure. Range time is roughly 3-4 hours. \$125.
USCCA Womens Basic Handgun Beginner	This is a basic handgun class for ladies.	None – this class is designed for those with zero gun experience or knowledge. Must be a woman.	Proper clothing for the range.	Roughly 5 hours including classroom and range /\$80
NRA First Steps Pistol or Rifle Beginner	This is a condensed basic gun class that focuses on semi-automatics only.	None – this class is designed for those with zero gun experience or knowledge.	Proper clothing for the range.	Roughly 5 hours including classroom and range / \$80
*Pistol Skill Builder Clinics Beginner - Intermediate	The clinic builds on basic skills and builds muscle memory by shooting correctly while under supervision. Drills are skill level appropriate. *Beyond the Basics Pistol Class Beginner	Designed to expand on the skills learned in a basic course. This class focuses on building speed through repetition, efficiency, and confidence. New skills include the different types of magazine changes, fixing type I – III malfunctions and more..	Must have completed a Basic Pistol Class, Clinic or similar training.	Your own firearm 200 rounds of factory ammunition. Range safety gear 2 dummy rounds	1 hours in the classroom and 2 hours on the range/ \$100
Gun Cleaning Class Beginner	Learn how to break down and thoroughly clean your firearm. Bring your nasty gun and we'll make it all shiny. Don't have one? CCW/Holster Prep Beginner - Intermediate	This is an optional class and is an introduction to the equipment and skills needed to competently carry and/or draw from a holster. Topics will also include legal issues, equipment options and clothing considerations. Dry fire and laser targets will be used in the class.	Recommended – Beyond The Basics Students must have completed a basic handgun course. Students should have good/safe gun handling skills and familiarity. While an intermediate skill level is suggested, it is not required. *NRA Personal Protection in the Home Intermediate	A must class for everyone that owns a firearm for personal or home protection. We'll cover the laws, logistics and specific skills needed to use deadly force to defend yourself in your home or on your property. We'll cover rapid fire, shooting from cover/concealment, shooting while moving, creating a safe room and hardening your home.	Recommended – Beyond The Basics Students must have completed a Basic Handgun course and be competent in all aspects of shooting their firearm including loading, firing, unloading, making the weapon safe, clearing malfunctions/jams and field stripping/cleaning their firearm. There is a shooting prerequisite for this class.	Your own firearm 300 rounds of factory ammunition. Defensive Handgun & SD County CCW Advanced	Completion of this course satisfies the requirements of the San Diego County Sheriffs Department for Concealed Carry Training. This challenging course will cover the legal aspects of personal defense in public, how to avoid conflict and recognize dangerous situations, the effects of adrenaline on your body, the aftermath of a defensive shooting in public, concealed carry equipment and considerations among other topics.	Recommended – CCW Prep I & II This is an advanced course designed to train you to carry a loaded firearm in public. Students should be competent in all aspects of shooting, loading, clearing and maintaining their personal firearm. Students should also have some holster experience before taking this class. There is a shooting prerequisite for this class.	Your own firearm 2 magazines 2 dummy rounds Holster, sturdy belt Magazine holster 300 rounds of factory ammunition.
