AFL-CIO Report:

Building report:

Political Education:

HR 82 the Social Security fairness act has been resubmitted before the 188th Congress. As of this submission it has 287 co-sponsors.

H.R. 856 / S.274 <u>paid</u> family leave bill has been introduced in the House and Senate. This would provide paid FMLA instead of having to use your own leave. This is only being proposed and has not passed yet. 35 Co-Sponsors in the house and 10 in the Senate.

H.R. 618 / S.131 Improving Access to Workers Compensation. This bill allows OWCP to accept Physician Assistants as well as doctors, this makes getting approved easier.

Vehicle & Safety:

Heat illness training must be given by April 1st every year. If you have not received the training, please notify your steward. We are filing grievances about the postal services failure to provide the training as well as falsification of training records. If your steward asks for a statement, please assist us, and provide a statement.
