

FROM THE DESK OF THE PRESIDENT

I would like to take a moment and thank all the members for their professionalism during this time and assure you we will be there when we are needed. One item to mention are Postal finances. It is imperative that the Postal Service be included I the next stimulus bill. Due to the pandemic we have experienced a huge loss in volume. We will address Postal Reform later, for now we really need a helping hand from Congress in the way of the stimulus. Other businesses are getting the help needed, we are no different.

You can help several ways. #1 & #3 are the quickest ways to help.

- 1.) Text USPS to 50409. This will generate a letter to your congressional representative asking for Postal Support.
- 2.) Write a letter to your congressional rep and explain the importance of keeping a strong U.S. Postal Service.
- 3.) Donate to the Letter Carrier Political Fund. Call me (585) 721-7397 to find out how.
- 4.) Vote this November and remember those who support us, these are the people we need in office. Support us we support you.

With this pandemic there have been several memorandums and legislative efforts to help our employees deal with family care issues. The Families First Coronavirus Response Act provides for 2/3 pay to take care of childcare paid by the government. This leave is in addition to your annual and sick leave. While it is only 2/3 pay it is available for up to 12 weeks to care for your children when there is no other care giver available (Daycare is closed and Schools are closed). This leave counts against your FMLA entitlement so if you have already used FMLA that would cut into your 12 weeks. This act runs from April 1 – December 31, 2020.

The Act furthers provides 2 weeks of full pay should you need it as a result of COVID-19 symptoms or a need due to other conditions which can be affected by COVID-19. Keep in mind in either case listed above the first 2 weeks must be taken all at once. For the childcare the remaining 10 weeks can be used intermittently. Questions about this Family First Coronavirus Response act should be directed to the Union office at 427-2450.
