H.R. 82 the Social Security fairness act now has 301 co-sponsors including all representatives in New York except for Claudia Tenny (R) from the 24th district and Hakeem Jefferies (D) from the 8th. A hearing was recently held in Baton Rouge Louisiana concerning this legislation by the Way and Means Committee.

OWCP Claims. Ecomp.dol.gov. We are still having issues with Continuation of Pay COP being paid. If one of your carriers gets hurt (Trematic injury) (CA-1), ask them if they are getting paid COP, if not please contact the union office for advise on filing a grievance.

Injured at work, you do NOT have to go to Urgent Care or Immediate Care. They have no Physicians, ONLY Physician assistants and Nurse Practitioners. Employee Labor Manual and DOL laws state choice of Physicians is yours NOT managements. Management does have a right to send you to a qualified contract physician or equivalent. As the Department of Labor does NOIT accept nurse practitioners or Physician assistants these medical people are NOT physician equivalents and therefore you do not have to go to an urgent care center that does not have an actual doctor. If you need immediate medical attention the NALC suggest you go to the emergency room and see a doctor.
