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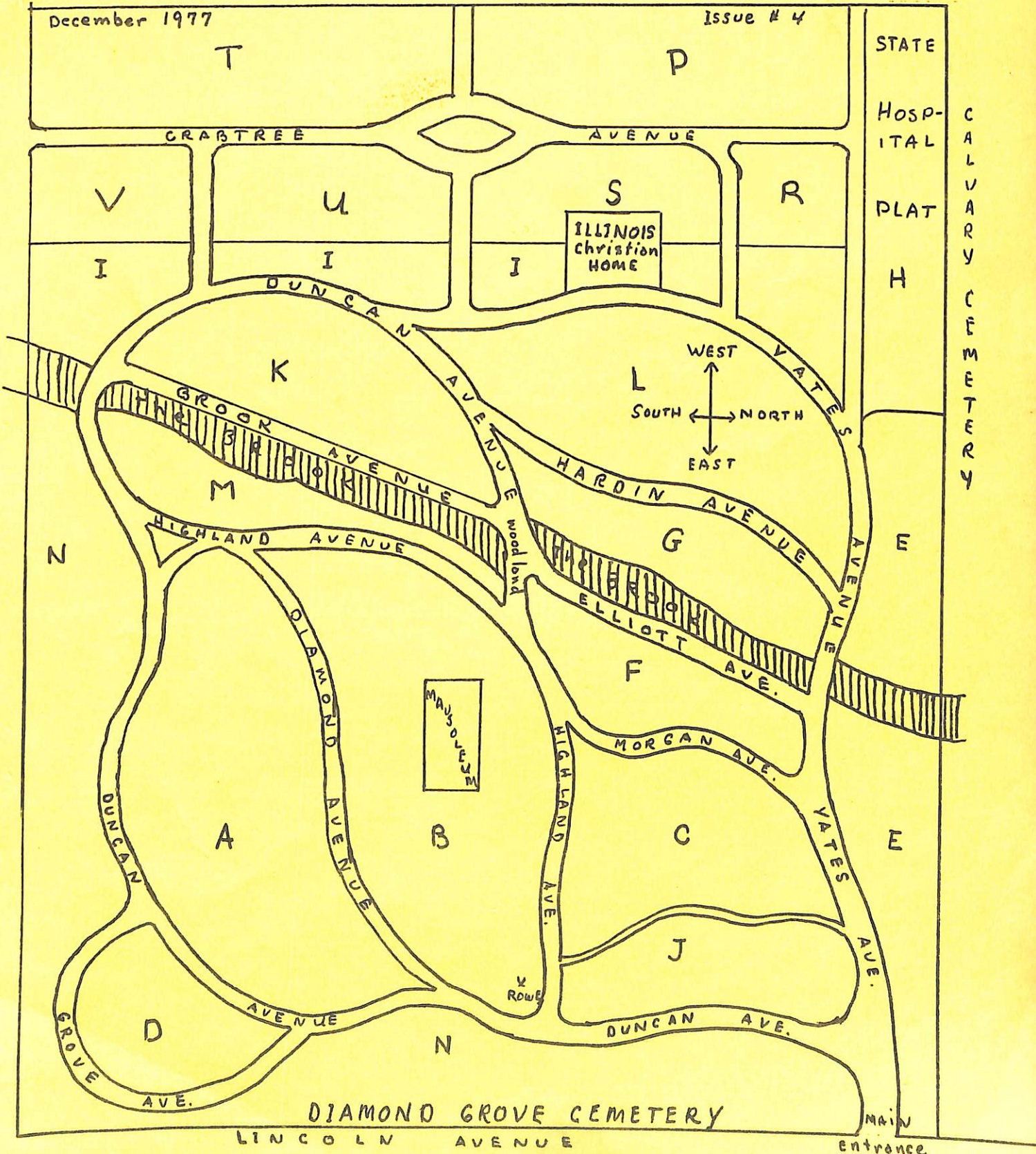

Will in-town members and those nearby please get your xeroxed copies at the Jacksonville Public Library. You will be charged 10 cents per page there, and can choose those you wish.

If you are considering purchasing one for posterity, your order needs to come immediately. It is completely indexed. They are \$16.00, size about 11 x 14.

We have a few copies of our 1976 *Jacksonville (IL) Geneal Journals* available at \$2.00 each, March, June, September and December. Specify which quarterly you want. The September and December issues have hundreds of burials from tombstone readings of our oldest cemetery - Jacksonville East.

The March 1976 issue has all male and female names in Marriages, Morgan County, 1827 to 1837.

Many of our members are working on indexing of various kinds, and our files are growing. Elizabeth Hardy has just completed indexing the *Portrait and Biographical Album of Morgan and Scott Counties, Illinois*, Chapman Brother, Chicago, 1889. This will enable us to find references to many more biographies.

YOU NEED US to supply the records, and WE NEED YOUR SUPPORT to help with the financing of our volunteer endeavors in genealogy. Together we can accomplish miracles in the gathering of family history.

May we urge you to copy your family records and get them in readable shape as soon as possible! We hope not, but you might suddenly be thrust on the other side of Life. What would you leave behind, for all of your research efforts? A lot of unintelligible scribbling? or an orderly family history booklet that others could pick up, add to, and work on with pleasure? If you can't afford to publish a big book, make some smaller "family booklets". Divide your maternal and paternal lineages so as to avoid confusion of names, and trying to figure out how to put families together who are not related, except for the #1 person (usually yourself). [unless you have some cousin-marriages.]

If you are waiting for people to answer your pleas for information, publish without them, for the first time, and promise to make a supplement later. Family history is too controversial in private and public records to strive for perfection, normally. If you wait to "sift out all the facts", there won't be any facts down on paper for other to sift. 'Nuff said sifters?

FROM OUR HOUSE(S) TO YOUR HOUSE

The Bicentennial year of 1976 sped swiftly, and now 1977 has nearly ended at the same fast pace. What all did YOU accomplish this year, genealogically speaking? May you have enough successes to keep you going, enough failures to keep you on your toes, and enough friends to encourage you to continue in the coming year.

That this is my privileged editorial¹ to over 260 members around the world seems incredible in the five short years of vigorous genealogical activity. (We now have members in Australia, South America and Canada.) As we evaluate our successes we find much has been accomplished in capturing family history statistics for a stay on permanent indexes, various family charts and numerous interesting letters we are trying to file methodically. We appreciate all that has been sent to us, and take this opportunity to thank the many people who have sent family charts and surname index cards. Many people have been inspired to start working on their lineage, and quite a few individuals have been assisted over dead-end walls. Unfortunately many letters have been unanswered for lack of research and answering time. (Maybe I can get to some of them next year!) All of those who have volunteered to assist in various ways, it seems, live away from here. Those few of us in this immediate area are doing the best we can to keep up.

Let me clear a misunderstanding as noted by recent requests for newsletters some of our members complain about not receiving. Evidently they read in the Illinois State Gen. Soc. Quarterly that we "publish the *Geneal Journal* and newsletters." I have tried to correct that statement, but have failed so far. We do not publish such letters currently because we are issuing 4 quarterlies. The postage is high because we are forced to send them third class. Our postmaster will not accept them at book or library rate. Bulk rate is cheaper, but we do not have anyway of mailing 200 or more pieces of mail at one time. Lucille and I have to work at the job "in bits and pieces". We had sent some newsletters and membership lists in previous years in lieu of a quarterly, as we were then just developing our publishing activities "from scratch".

When genealogists write to us usually their requests and addresses are briefly noted in Lucille's news items in our local newspapers. We rarely know if inquirers receive answers from other individuals; however, there have been several happy people who have found each other this way.

We do not publish a Query Column in our Journal, generally, because we have too many vital indexes to pass on which benefit more people. The number of pages per Journal is limited for several reasons. We try to squeeze in as much as possible, yet keeping it easily readable for which we have received several compliments. Ed spends at least six months of her year researching and typing the four Journals, each one being equal to a Master's thesis in wordage, we have recently discovered.

Ed is now a history major at Sangamon State which uses up some precious time in travel and assignments, but techniques learned will be quite rewarding to our genealogical pursuits eventually, we hope. Our family seekers need to learn more about historical methodology and proper documentation of their vital statistics. This has been a neglected area of learning in group instruction. I hope to teach better use of tape recorders for family reminiscences soon. Barbara Gross and I were going to present a tape recording demonstration at the December Society meeting, but it was cancelled because of inclement (plus) weather.

Dr. Cullom Davis, my Advisor at Sangamon State University, is a specialist in the national field of producing Memoirs from taped interviews. His new manual *Oral History From Tape To Type* is now available at \$8.95 postpaid from "Order Dept. American Library Assn, 50 E. Huron Street, Chicago ILL 60611." I highly recommend you order² a copy immediately in order to develop your own expertise as a family historian.

Page 2: From Our House(s) To Your House

I was privileged to be a speaker before the Kiwanis Club on ladies night in Winchester last month. I developed some new teaching aids and Family History Charts for them in hopes that interest could be sparked in starting a genealogical AND historical society in Scott County. If I was not successful in that venture, at least I had great success in producing some new charts which I am going to pass on to you, my faithful members. Let me know whether they are good or bad, and if you have suggestions for change or improvement I would welcome the information soon. In addition to this Quarterly, therefore, you will receive copies of the "New Hutchison-method Lineage Charts." Their best feature is an index on the back of the family history charts.

It is so frustrating to "find the people" on a chart full of four or five generations with all that statistical data that is ^{so} necessary. By listing them alphabetically on the back, with Chart Number, one can turn it over and easily find the one they are seeking. To my knowledge, no other chart has ever included this feature. Always use fine-point pens on such charts. The new Flair HARDHEAD and Bic F-29 Fine Pt. are both good, if the chart is not typed.

While I am enclosing one of the usual 7-generation charts of two pages, you will have to look closely at the rest of them since they follow a new rule. I have separated the Paternal Lineage from the Maternal Lineage, so that each page will contain related families. Instead of having 7 generations of mother's AND father's ancestors, each page has the lineage of one parent only of the Number One person. These are loose, except for one staple, rather than being fastened in the Quarterly so that you can separate them for reproduction on a xerox, or for copying in any way that you or your local society desires. This is our "Bonus of Love" to you at this 1977 Christmas Holiday season.

Our Greene County marriage indexes published in June and September (1977) have probably helped more people than any other work. To finish it up please note the biographical index of their 1973 Atlas on pages 25-26 this Journal.

We are currently preparing cards for Morgan County marriages 1827-1860 to publish, hopefully, in our next Journal, March 1978.

I can never end without trying to find a bit of poetry that expresses my best wishes to all of you "out there", and this one by K. N. Davis is "it" for now:

The World is full of beauty -- Sparkling seas,
A Garden in full bloom, -- The shape of trees,
A Child's eyes dancing, -- With some new delight,

DIAMOND GROVE CEMETERY

On a beautiful autumnal afternoon, in the month of September, 1860, a large concourse of people gathered to witness the dedication of Diamond Grove Cemetery. On reaching the cemetery, the company gathered about a fine monument standing near the entrance. [The entrance has since been moved to the northeast corner.] "It is of white Italian marble, with a square base about 3 feet in diameter, and 3 feet high above the pedestal to the shaft of 3 feet in height, surmounted with a wreath, making the whole height of the monument 13 feet.

. . . and its historic inscriptions at once explain the fact that the cemetery itself bears the same name given it by the first pioneers of the county." On the western base of the monument appears the following inscription: "1860. Erected by the County of Morgan, to the Memory of ISAAC FORT ROE, one of three first settlers, and the first person who died in this county."

Facing the driveway on the north side of the monument, is a bas-relief representation of him who sleeps beneath, in his pioneer dress, with rifle on his left arm, and broad-ax in his right hand, while in the distance the pioneer's cabin is seen. He died 12 October 1821, aged 48 years.

Roe, David Berdan and George Nixon were appointed by an emigration society in the City of New York, October 12, 1819 to explore the Western States and select places of settlement for its members. They passed and named Diamond Grove January 23, 1820. The grove of trees, shimmering with ice, had the sun in the right direction to make it appear as myriads of shining diamonds. Isaac Fort Roe built a log cabin there in February, and became one of the first three settlers in the county, the others being Seymour and Elisha Kellogg. Many were at the dedication who knew Mr. Roe, and could testify to the facts narrated. Dr. Chandler, who attended him in his last illness, and Mr. Hiram Reeve who had in his possession the nails used in making the original linn-tree coffin. [The nails were undoubtedly made by his blacksmith father, Isaac Reeve, who first settled south of Diamond Grove near Roe.]

Isaac Fort Roe was the son of Dr. Ozel Roe, of Woodbridge, New Jersey. Dr. Chandler said: "He was a man of highly cultivated mind, of religious tastes and habits, and of gently, pious character." Referring to his prior burial 48 years past: "There was not a plank to be had to make a coffin. Judge Wilson and others cut a tree, split out puncheons, hewed and planed them, and made as good a coffin as they could under the circumstances. He had no relations to mourn his loss: no sermon was preached, no prayers were said, scarcely a word was spoken: but silent and sad we deposited his remains in the grave." [The fact that "Judge Wilson" helped to make a coffin inclines me to believe that Roe was first buried in College Hill or Wil(l)son's Grove Cemetery where Turner School now stands. Shortly after 1860 Mr. Kirby and others moved a lot of bodies from there to the new Diamond Grove. However, I have not found other evidence of this, except noting who helped make the coffin.]

To perpetuate the memory of Mr. Roe as a first county settler, first inhabitant of the grove, and first to die in the limits of Old Morgan then including Cass and Scott, Messrs. Joseph Morton, Hiram Reeve, Judge Whitlock and Dr. Chandler were appointed by the County Court to have this monument erected. Visitors now entering the new entrance to the cemetery, turn left on Duncan Avenue to Highland that rambles in front of the Mausoleum. At the northeast point of Section 3, Lot 323-4 one finds Roe's historic monument. [His name was inadvertently omitted in our Index!]

The 40 acres for the cemetery had been purchased in 1867 by the City of Jacksonville. City Surveyor was Rufus Crampton of Illinois College fame, and architect of many buildings and our famous Octagon House. It was he who laid out this very unique cemetery plat. As I have studied and worked with the original plat I found

in Deed Book 72 at the Courthouse, it appears that he followed the natural contours of the land for drainage purposes, basically, accomodating the brook running across the upper mid-section. The City presently is in the process of filling in this land feature to make room for about 200 more lots.

Please notice that the Avenues have been named for over one hundred years. It would be great if we could get the present Cemetery Board to put up street markers since they are names of some of our great men of this area, and we now have a map by which to guide visitors to the correct section. Would some of you be interested in writing a letter to the Mayor and Cemetery Board making such a request?

For two years I and a few faithful family historians have been working on Diamond Grove cemetery readings, so are sending you the index of Sections A and B. I got up at 5:00 o'clock one morning determined to draw a map of the cemetery from the original plat I had xeroxed and piecedtogether which was about 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet by 3 feet in size. Using the old art trick of marking it off in squares, I was able to freehand it to graph paper. It worked, and so you see the happy results on the cover of this Journal. Now you can drive in the Main Entrance (if not in your car -- your mind's eye) and using the map find whichever section you desire. I am trying to make detailed section maps to show where the lots are located, and have Section A finished, but did not have room to include it here. You will find copies of burials in Sections A, B and C at the Jacksonville Public Library and the Illinois State Historical Library.

If you want copies of the LOT CARD from the City Clerk's Office they will xerox it for a minimum charge of \$1.00. They can get 2 lots on one card, in case you want more than one, and they will not make extra charge for the second one. These are special arrangements I have made with them for your convenience in getting such statistics as name and burial date.

DO NOT write to the City Clerk giving the name of an individual and expect them to find it. All of their records are filed chronologically - they do not have alphabetical indexes as yet. That is the purpose of the work we are doing, and it will be a long time before I am able to get these hundreds of cards alphabetized. How desperately I need a responsible volunteer typist to help me finish this job! To hire one is prohibitive in cost. At the rate that one person charged for 3 pages your Society would have to pay \$120 just to make the master sheets for one Journal!

For alphabetical listings you send to the County Clerk for all deaths from 1878 to the present. The charge is \$3.00 per certificate, as required by State Law. This charge also applies for Birth and Marriage certificates.

Note the State Hospital Section H in the upper right corner. The stones up to 1945 are a concrete post about 6 inches square with a number on it. I always wondered where the names were that went with it. Through sheer luck I have come up with hundreds of names from 1930 (Nov.) up to the present. That is another record that needs typing. ALL State Hospital deaths are on file at the County Clerk's office from 1878 on. They do not list the lot number, however. Only I have the spot number available. NOBODY has any record of the chronological order of burials from 1868 to 1930, so do not write for them. We are looking for that vital Burial Ledger at the State Hospital, but it has not turned up yet: when it does we will let you know. I did find deaths from 1852 to 1867 and have turned the list over to be published in the Ill. State Gen. Soc. Quarterly.

One of the forms included with this mailing will be one for sending for birth, death and marriages to County Clerks. Please save it as a model. You can xerox copies to use, or use the form by making your own on the typewriter or by hand. Please make it easy for our County Clerks to fill your orders.

The above biographies we have xeroxed out of the Greene County 1873 Atlas, and have them pasted on typing paper, each one on a sheet or two, as listed. We could xerox these and send to our out of town members.

Those persons living in this vicinity will find copies of this ATLAS at our Jacksonville Public Library and at Carrollton. There is also a copy at the Illinois State Historical Library, and probably one at the new Sangamon Valley Collection, the Genealogical Division at the newly-opened Lincoln Library in Springfield.

May I remind family history seekers at this point to always send LONG stamped envelopes whenever they expect returns of materials they are requesting. It keeps the records in better shape for inserting into notebooks or other filing systems, and if a researcher has additional items to include, the envelope is not so puffy.

The last word I had was that this marvelous Atlas is still available from the Greene County Historical Society at \$10.00 plus \$1.25 postage. These are "rejects" they acquired; but the only thing wrong is a page or two bound up-side-down, or missing. They have taken one book apart, and inserted the missing pages, so the book is, in reality, complete. This is the best buy you will ever get on Greene County History! Their Museum is at 221 North Fifth Street, Carrollton ILL 62016.

THE OVERSTREET FAMILY BIBLE READINGS

Mrs. Lloyd H. Hymes purchased an old Bible at a flea market last year "simply because it was an old Bible (1853)." We are sharing the information with our readers:

"Reuben Overstreet was born the 13th of August 1824.

Dosia Ann Overstreet was born May the 9th, 1825.

William T. Overstreet was born December the 29th, 1847.

Reuben Overstreet was born March the 14th, 1821.

Sandridge Overstreet was born October 25th, 1854.

James W. Overstreet was born February the 25th, 1857.

Sarah Dosia Overstreet born June 17, 1858.

Joel (could be John)-----Overstreet born November 27th, 1861

Victora Miller was born 1883, died July 12, 1885.

Ethel Overstreet was born September 20, 1889.

Reuben Overstreet died November 11, 1869.

Gertie Adcox, born January 22, 1879.

Thomas Overstreet left Scott County, Ill. for Kentucky, April the first 1857.

Mr. Homer Clark died May 30, 1963, age 82 yr. 9 mo. 8 da."

Following is a newspaper clipping (no date indicated) of Mrs. Sarah HORTON:

"Sarah Dosia Overstreet, daughter of Reubon and Dosia Overstreet, was born in Exeter on June 17, 1859, and departed this life at her home in Exeter on January 13, 1938, at the age of 78 years and five months. She had been declining in health for several years.

"She was preceded in death by four brothers, namely; William, Reubon, James M. and Joel Andy, who passed away some three weeks ago.

"She was united in marriage to Oscar Clark on Oct. 2, 1886. He passed away Dec. 26, 1922. Three children were born to this union, namely; Lennie Clark, who died in the fall of 1895, Sophia Clark, sying in infancy, and Henry Clark of Bowling Green, Mo., who survives.

"The deceased is also survived by one granddaughter, Betty Jane Clark of Griggs-ville, one great niece, Mrs. Juanita Lawson, and one great nephew, Vitalis Teaney.

"She was married to Frank Horton on July 17, 1925, and from that date until the time of her death they made their home in Exeter.

"Funeral services were conducted from the Christian church in Exeter Saturday morning at 10:30, Rev. F. V. Wright of Winchester officiating.

"The singing was in charge of Mrs. Frances Brackett, Mrs. Florence Brackett, Miss Letchie Peak and Mrs. Holly Clinton, with Mrs. Mary Whitlock at the piano. The songs were: "Pass Me Not O Gentle Saviour", "Abide with Me" and "Jesus Keep Me Near the Cross."

"The pall bearers were Fritz Rolf, Wm. Rolf, Harry Chambers, Chas. Funk, Theodore Boes and Jesse Carter. Burial was in the Exeter cemetery."
