

Dear Friends and Relatives(?):

Many of you have complained that our Journals "stop you from your housework", because as soon as you get it you just have to sit down and read it! Thanks for the compliments. This Journal won't be noted for its literary value, but it is loaded with hundreds of names that ought to "ring a bell" with somebody out there.

Please consider this a Double Issue for June and August (or whenever the next one is due). There are several reasons for this. In the first place, we have printed on both sides of the page, because of the automatic offset method. They number past 50, and 25 is the usual number for an issue.

Thirdly, your Editor needs a rest from planning an issue and spending the many hours necessary to pull it all together and get it typed in perfect order, as she desires to make a worthwhile journal out of any that are produced. This issue contains two major productions - that pertain to the publication "Old Cass County Cemeteries" by Arthur Crumrin in 1966 and 1970 - and the related Old Morgan County 1830 Census. This was abstracted from one of the four volumes compiled by Maryan R. and James V. Gill, and was apropos in connection with Cass County, because there are many people listed in this Census that are buried in Cass. Another related index was pulled from the 1882 History of Cass. Ed also spent MANY evening hours making the Surname Index for the cemetery book.

Those of you who purchased the Crumrin book will find much use of that particular section of this Journal pertaining to "Old Cass County Cemeteries". Should anyone not a member want a copy, they can purchase a copy of this issue of the *Jacksonville Geneal Journal*, June-August 1975 for \$2.50 each, or become a member for \$5.00 per year and receive our other issues for the year.

We want to thank all of you who purchased the 1878 History books of Morgan County we offered. We sold more than 350 copies, and have only a very few left. We are preparing to offer a Unigraphic reprint of the 1872 Atlas Map and the 1894 Plat Map of Morgan County, plus a Surname Index for both, all under one cover, this fall. Several of our members are working hard on compiling the cards and lists for the various township maps, biographies, and township lists. You will receive notice of this rare publication in due time.

We have only a few copies of the Jean Maire publication "Early Marriages, Early Residents and Where They Came From, Court Records, and Civil War Roll of Honor" which pertains to Greene and Jersey Counties. Price reduced from \$4.50 to \$3.50. Money will be refunded if all copies are sold ahead of your order.

One of my interesting side trips has been to the Arcadia annual Memorial Day program in the little church at the front of the cemetery, sponsored by the Arcadia Woman's Club. It was well attended, and had the distinct flavor of the old-fashioned church services we rather long for, in this busy world.

The secretary of the cemetery association has let me study the oldest records on file, from which I pulled this very interesting history by David G. Henderson in 1874. There is not a sign of a punctuation mark in its entirety. I copied it as faithfully as possible. I catalogued the first 260 sales of cemetery lots, beginning in 1874, and made an alphabetical index of purchasers. It will take many hours of poring over handwritten records by the various sextons before we can determine the final ownership of each lot, and learn who is buried on each one. There is no such record, however, for the old part of the cemetery on the north end. But we do have some record of the removal of some "corps" from some unknown place to a specific Lot Number.

One of the most valuable genealogical records in the possession of cemetery association secretaries, are the little slips of papers and letters written when lots were transferred by the heirs of someone who purchased a lot. I am going to assist the secretary some day in going through the old boxes of records trying to pull out these transfer slips - both to get family connections, and to record lot transfers for the association. This will be a help to both of us, and may aid you to find where your people moved to after being in the Arcadia area. "How long, O Lord, How long" will it take us to "get a round TU-IT"?

Many of you have wondered about the 1850 Morgan County Census record. We have just received the first 13% from James Parker of Utah, for which we are very grateful, and are taking steps to try to complete it this fall.

We had hopes of publishing the 1880 Scott County Census donated to us by George E. Caldwell and Mary Lou Whitlaw, who also became Life Members. The moving process of the printer eliminates this currently. If some of you would pay \$15.00 for a xerox copy, complete with index, perhaps we could arrange this. There are 181 pages plus index. I hate to see it sitting here unused. George and Mary Lou did a splendid job on this, and are working on the 1850 and 1860 censuses. We appreciate such ardent fans.


Mrs. Doris Sanford of Coral Gables, Florida, another Life Member, has just completed an index of 1868-1888 Jacksonville East Cemetery burials for us, from records copied and sent to her. We are preparing to send an extension of this, so that we can extend the record to 1900. Xeroxed copies of the 1868-1888 burials are in the Jacksonville Public Library, The City Clerk's office, and the County Clerk's office.

I must comment on how one or two genealogists can ruin a congenial set-up with County Officials for all the other people eager to get family history information from the Courthouses. Please, learn to be courteous to the busy officials, not too demanding, and certainly do not upset normal procedures. Pay for xeroxing done of records at the required amounts, and be happy for the service!

We had very congenial relationships established here in Morgan County, but out-of-staters came in and requested to make use of a personal copier "so's to save money". When the request was made in the Circuit Court, naturally the assistant said that she would have to get the permission of the County Judge. These people very carelessly handled old bits and pieces of court records which were nearly 150 years old, as though they were on tough new paper. They spilled them on the floor. They were told that these were filed in a certain order, originally, according to date of access by the court. This involved much time and concern for the assistant handling the situation. This upset the normal procedures, and the Judge ruled that hereafter NO ONE could get the records and copy them, except for the clerks, under regular procedures. This tightened the rules and regulations in securing, looking at, and making use of such documents for everybody in the future!

Another instance some avid researchers "upset the apple cart". Our people who read a certain cemetery, had very carefully set broken pieces of old stones into the ground, anchoring them so that when mowing was done, they would not break them further. Persons looking for their relatives, not content with the information down on paper, pulled all of these stones up trying to get a better look, and left them lying helter skelter on the ground! This is so discouraging for our Society members who are trying so hard to protect your heritage of the past. PLEASE - help us to help you and yours.

THE END - for one reason only - no more space!



## EARLY CASS COUNTY

Joshua P. CROW, Amos BONNEY and George F. MILLER were elected Commissioners of the newly formed County of Cass on the seventh day of August, 1837. Convening August 14, 1837, the oath of office was administered to them by Thomas POGUE, and acting Justice of the Peace, in and for said County. The Commissioners proceeded to divide the County into six Magistrate's and Constable's Districts, as shown on the map.

The THREE MILE STRIP running East and West across the South of the County was not made a part of Cass County until May, 1845. Prior to that time, deeds and other records will be found in the Morgan County Courthouse.

CEMETERY AND SURNAME INDEXES FOR "OLD CASS COUNTY CEMETERIES"  
BY ARTHUR CRUMRIN, 1970 and 1966 Editions

These Cemetery and Surname Indexes, and a Table of Contents for Arthur Crumrin's "Old Cass County Cemeteries" have been prepared by Mrs. Florence Hutchison, president of the Jacksonville Area Genealogical and Historical Society, and chairman of the Bicentennial Committee of the Jacksonville Woman's Club, in cooperation with Mr. Crumrin. This is a cemetery indexing-publishing Community Improvement Project sponsored jointly by the Society, the Woman's Club, and the Morgan County Bicentennial Commission. Mrs. Hutchison is vice-president of this Bicentennial Commission, and chairman of the County Archives committee. Our purpose is to make cemetery and other public records more available to family history seekers as our contribution to the heritage phase of the 200th anniversary celebration of the United States. - "HERITAGE U.S."

For the benefit of those people who might own a copy of "Old Cass County Cemeteries", either the 1966 edition, or the 1970 edition (which was badly put together for reasons beyond control after printing), we have prepared

1. A Surname Index so that any person might be found in the 132 cemeteries
2. A Cemetery Index that includes the township and range references, and page numbers in both editions
3. Explanatory remarks as to why and how to correct the confusion of pages, cemeteries and townships in the 1970 edition
4. A Table of Contents for the 1970 edition which will assist the owners of this book to renumber their pages for easier reference

You would be wise to take this Table of Contents for the 1970 edition, and the Indexes to the libraries, if you do not own a copy. The Illinois State Historical Library has a copy. Perhaps, if the library does not have the index included with this issue of the *Jacksonville (IL) Geneal Journal*, you could permit them to xerox a copy of these pages to put with their book, or they could write to us for a separate set we will put together for a one dollar donation to cover costs. This excellent cemetery record book "OLD CASS COUNTY CEMETERIES", first printed in 1966, and later printed in 1970 with many additional cemetery readings, was badly put together by the publishers when the second printing was done. With no Table of Contents, nor an Index, pages printed on wrong sides, one page a duplicate of another, lack of township designation on certain pages, and many other factors, this book has little value unless one searches names of his ancestors page by page of the 96 unnumbered pages. Should he do so, there are bits and pieces of continuations one cannot place with its proper cemetery.

Mrs. Hutchison has completed a surname index for these 132 cemeteries, but in order for one to find the proper names on a given page under a specific cemetery, it is necessary that the pages of these books be hand-numbered by its owner. To accomplish uniform results, she has prepared a Table of Contents using the first words on each page, or name and number of cemetery. Follow directions given for collating and renumbering pages.

There were also differences in identifying cemeteries in the 1970 edition. (23) is listed as JOKISCH. A very fine addition was contributed under the title "JOCKISCH METHODIST CEMETERY (German Methodist)" 1969, compiled by Janice (Lovekamp) Fox, Hester (Ham) Lovekamp, and Mabel (Smith) Schnitker. It was not

not given a number, but will be referred to as (23b), since it is in the same township and range as (23) Jokisch. In addition, pages printed on the wrong side of the sheet caused this contribution to be split in several parts. Starting on the title page with 32, going through 39, it is continued on page 55, back to 41, if you number your pages according to the Table of Contents.

"Country Graveyards: Number Four. The Karr Graveyard." by Hon. J.N. Gridley. These six pages are from Mr. J. N. Gridley's book "*Historical Sketches*" recorded in 1906 or 1907. COUNTRY GRAVEYARDS will be classed as being (46) KARR. Fortunately these pages are in proper sequence, 26 through 31.

There were some additional cemeteries in the 1970 edition, not in the 1966 edition. These pages were scattered through the book because of printing on the wrong side of the page. They start with BUCK on page 82, GEBHARDT page 84, GATTON (cont'd) on page 85, skipping back to UNKNOWN (cont'd) on page 8. This page also includes HOLLER, DIRREEN, WATKINS and PONTIAC (132), the last cemetery of this series.

One cemetery was accidentally left out by the typist, Mr. Crumrin informed me. This was (69) WAGLE. This reading is provided at the end of the Table of Contents.

There were some additional readings for cemeteries in the 1970 edition which were not identified by section, township or range, nor name of township - just number and name. These are found on pages 92 through 96, if you number your pages according to this system. These are identified in the Table of Contents.

Here is how you can eventually remedy the situation with your book, or one that you use at a library.

1. Refer to Table of Contents, and read directions for collating and renumbering pages. You have 3 courses of action:
  - a. Number the pages in your book same as the Table of Contents regardless as to page succession;
  - b. or, number your pages through the book, and write the new number in the margins of the indexes;
  - c. or, number pages according to table of contents, then take book apart and reassemble and rebind.

If you scan the following Surname Index and need information from "Old Cass County Cemeteries:", and do not have a copy available either from your home, your genealogical or historical society, or public library, our Society would search for you if you request it, and send a stamped addressed long envelope. If it involves several names or pages of xeroxing an entire cemetery record, we would appreciate a donation of \$1.00 to cover costs. This index gives the names of people found in the various cemeteries, who fortunately for some researchers, presented a biography to have in the book, and some photographs, which will be listed herein. Materials of this kind are very valuable to family history seekers in this area.

I recommend that ANY person looking for people in ANY of these west central Illinois counties LOOK THESE SURNAME INDEXES OVER VERY CAREFULLY. The reason they might not have found their beloved people is because they may be looking in the wrong county!

The 1830 Census for this area is an example. Morgan is the county listed, not Scott nor Cass, because they were a part of what we now call "Old Morgan". But the people listed therein may have lived in any of the 3 counties.

*This article, found in the papers of the late Dr. C. P. McClelland, is published here not only for its genealogical content which may be of interest to some of our readers, but its historical value showing life in that period, and the routes Virginians travelled when coming to Morgan County around one hundred and fifty years ago.*

Samuel Sinclair was born to George and Margaret Craven Sinclair, June 8, 1808, near Leesburg, Virginia. At the time of his death February 7, 1888, he lacked only four months of having lived eighty years, and his life spanned a stirring and challenging period of our history, when great men and greater forces were shaping the pattern of national life in these young United States of America.

Born a son of the Old Dominion, Samuel Sinclair left his mother State in his early manhood, establishing his home and rearing his family in the then new State of Illinois. The close of his active and eventful life came in the capitol city of Springfield, where he had made his home for five years.

"Various indeed are the scenes and incidents through which Samuel Sinclair passed. He saw, at a distance of forty miles, the burning of Washington City by the British in the War of 1812; he heard the great debate in the United States Senate on the nullification question, and listened to the speech of Senator Calhoun and the immortalized reply of Daniel Webster, the great Massachusetts senator, to Calhoun and Hayne; he listened to the melting eloquence of Henry Clay, the great Kentuckian, and was present to hear his compromise speech in 1832; he was acquainted with General Jackson, Thomas Benton and others of that period. Many are the interesting reminiscences of men and events that he can give, which are yet fresh in his memory." (From *Atlas of Cass County*, Biographical Sketches by W. R. Brink, Published 1874).

The childhood and adolescent years of Samuel Sinclair's life were lived on his father's plantation comprising six or seven hundred acres in Loudon County. When he was eighteen years old, he was preparing himself at Leesburg Academy to enter the University of Virginia. One wonders, at this juncture, how different the pattern of his life might have been had he carried out his plans to enter the University. His father's death in 1826 changed completely the direction of this younger son's life, when it became necessary, then, to abandon plans for a college education and undertake the management of the plantation. One can feel fairly sure that it was a period of restlessness and dissatisfaction which, coupled perhaps with something of the same pioneering urge and adventuresome spirit that had brought his grandfather, John Sinclair, from Scotland in 1747 to the American Colonies, impelled him, in 1833, to go

out to Illinois to make the beginnings of his life there. The Institution of slavery did not rest easily on his mind. Many years later he said that he had been made an antislavery man as a youth, when he witnessed the whipping of a slave, and came to Illinois to get away from the evil influences of one race's holding in bondage another race.

It was in the spring of 1833 that Samuel Sinclair came west, embarking on the long river trip at Wheeling, West Virginia and traveling by boat down the Ohio river, north on the Mississippi as far as its junction with the Illinois river and over this river to Naples, Illinois in Pike County. He went on from there to Morgan County, arriving June 8, on his twenty-fifth birthday. He had brought with him only four hundred dollars, and with this he took up land grants from the Government, entering some 280 acres to which he soon made the addition of another 40 acres, making a half section in all. This land lay 8 miles northwest of Jacksonville, near the railroad station of Sinclair, later so named for Samuel.

In the fall of 1833, after securing this land, he returned to his home in Loudon County, Virginia and remained there for about a year and a half. It was within this time that he was united in marriage with Euphemia Craven, daughter of Josiah and Eleanor Shepherd Craven, on October 28th, 1834. In the spring of the following year, he brought his young wife to Illinois to share with him there life in this newer Commonwealth of the middle west. They traveled to Illinois over the same river route that Samuel had taken in 1833. He immediately entered upon the work of improving his farm in Morgan County upon which he lived for twenty-nine years, with the exception of one interval. This interval occurred between 1838 and 1845, during which he was completely broken financially, by allowing his name to be used too freely on other men's paper, coupled with the financial panic under the old banking laws of Illinois.

Though very hard pressed, he rejected the advice and solicitation of a number of friends to avail himself of the existing bankruptcy law. His reply was, "I had rather hire out as a farm-hand at ten dollars a month till my creditors are paid to the last cent than to shelter under a law with men who use its protection as a means of escaping the obligations of their plain contracts."

Having good credit, he commenced trading in live stock and then lands, and in a few years, succeeded in repurchasing his home place and several hundred additional acres. The homestead in Morgan County to which Samuel Sinclair

and his young wife came in 1835 was known as "Oak Hill" and is located a quarter of a mile from the Old Hebron church. It is still standing. Here were born their children, eleven in number, of whom nine grew to maturity. Here Euphemia Sinclair died April 23, 1862, and lies buried in the Old Hebron church-yard.

Doubtless this steadily growing family was the inspiration that spurred their father to overcome his financial losses and once more become established. In the spring of 1844, there came a pleasant break in the routine of his life. A business trip to New Orleans, when he accompanied a load of livestock to that southern market, coincided with the visit of Jenny Lind to that city for a series of concerts. A lover of music, it was an opportunity for the best that Samuel Sinclair could not miss, and he paid twenty-five dollars for the privilege of hearing this "Swedish Nightingale".

Upon his return, when he reached Jacksonville, he learned of the birth, on June 14, 1844 of his sixth child, a fourth son who was given the name of Henry Clay. Wishing to make a gift to his wife, Samuel took the required amount of silver money, realized from his business trip to New Orleans, to a silversmith and had made a half dozen each of teaspoons, dessert spoons and service spoons, a butter knife and a sugar spoon. Each piece was stamped with the name of the silversmith - J. W. King - and the words "Pure Coin" and was engraved with the monogram "S.S.". Of this set of flat silver, it is known of a certainty that only the six service spoons are, in 1940, in existence. They are now owned by the heirs of Henry Clay Sinclair.

On October 21, 1863, Samuel Sinclair married Dorothy Beggs, daughter of Capt. Charles Beggs. In 1864, he disposed of his Morgan County property and acquired land in Cass county, five miles northwest of the village of Ashland in what came to be known as the "Centenary Neighborhood", so named for the Centenary Methodist Episcopal Church built there in 1868.

Here Samuel Sinclair lived for nineteen years, improving and adding to his properties, and engaging in general agriculture and the livestock business, until his estate came to comprise 887 acres and the homestead. Here, in 1867, he built the large house that was to stand for over sixty years, until its destruction by fire in 1930; and, in 1870, a large barn that is still standing in 1940.

In 1883, Samuel Sinclair moved with his wife and their two daughters, Emma Lou and Margaret, to Springfield, Illinois, where he lived until the time of his death on February 7, 1888.

Reference from *History of Morgan County, Donnelley, Loyd & Co., 1878:*

SINCLAIR

Is a small station on the Chicago and Alton Railroad, seven miles north of Jacksonville. It was laid out Nov. 9, 1857, by Mr. Samuel Sinclair. It is in the midst of a fine farming region, and is a good shipping point, there being more than thirty-five thousand bushels of grain shipped from there during the year 1877. The first church in the town -- "Hebron Church" -- was erected in 1835, of logs, and was soon after enlarged, and in 1857 was replaced by the present church. Owing to the fact of the town being near old and larger places, it has not grown much. At present [1878] it contains only the church, doctor's office and residence, a blacksmith shop, a store, and the post-office.

# STATE HOSPITAL BURIALS IN DIAMOND GROVE CEMETERY, Morgan County

Your Editor, on one of her tours of Diamond Grove Cemetery, found rows and rows of small square concrete stones in the northwest corner. All they have is as number. Where were the names that went with the numbers?

We accidentally found many later ones on loose pages in a Cemetery Board book in the City Clerk's office. We have copied them, mostly by hand, and alphabetized them chronologically. Now we are going through the death certificates at the Courthouse in order to pull out additional information. When we finish this project, we can identify the resting place of 1100 State Hospital patients buried in Morgan County beginning with stone #273 of Elizabeth Smith, buried Nov 1930, up to stone #1330 of Alice Osborn buried 2 Nov 1954. To find the rest of hundreds more of these burials from 1878 to 1930 will require going through the death certificates. We are working on it "and thought you'd like to know".

We offer here some 1878-80 burials, with date of death, but there is no record as to stone #. We have not found this information, as yet.

This is a sample as to the information to be gleaned from death certificates. These came from a book, and not the original certificate. I look at the cemetery named, and coming across one from Diamond Grove, look at the column where place of death is listed. This is the easiest way to spot these burials. This record does not give County of origin, as does the original Admissions Record Books at the State Hospital. But these records are closed for public inspection, so do not waste your time trying to contact hospital officials for any records pertaining to your relatives.

Hospital records are CLOSED - period. Save your stamps. Look elsewhere for any other information you might need.

# REGISTER OF STILLBIRTHS FOR 1878-79 in Morgan County

Probing into old record books at the Courthouse can be quite rewarding, genealogically speaking. As your Editor was copying State Hospital burials in Diamond Grove Cemetery, from Death Certificates, she decided to look in Book 1, Register of Stillbirths, and to copy name of parents and their nativity for the members of our Society, for 1878-79, to see if anybody was interested in having further records from this book printed in our *Geneal Journal*. The record continues up to 1921, at which time the deaths were recorded with the regular death certificates.

This record is a good indication of people who lived in Morgan County who might not be found on other records. We will try one page to start with, and see if any of the names "rings a bell" with any of our readers.
