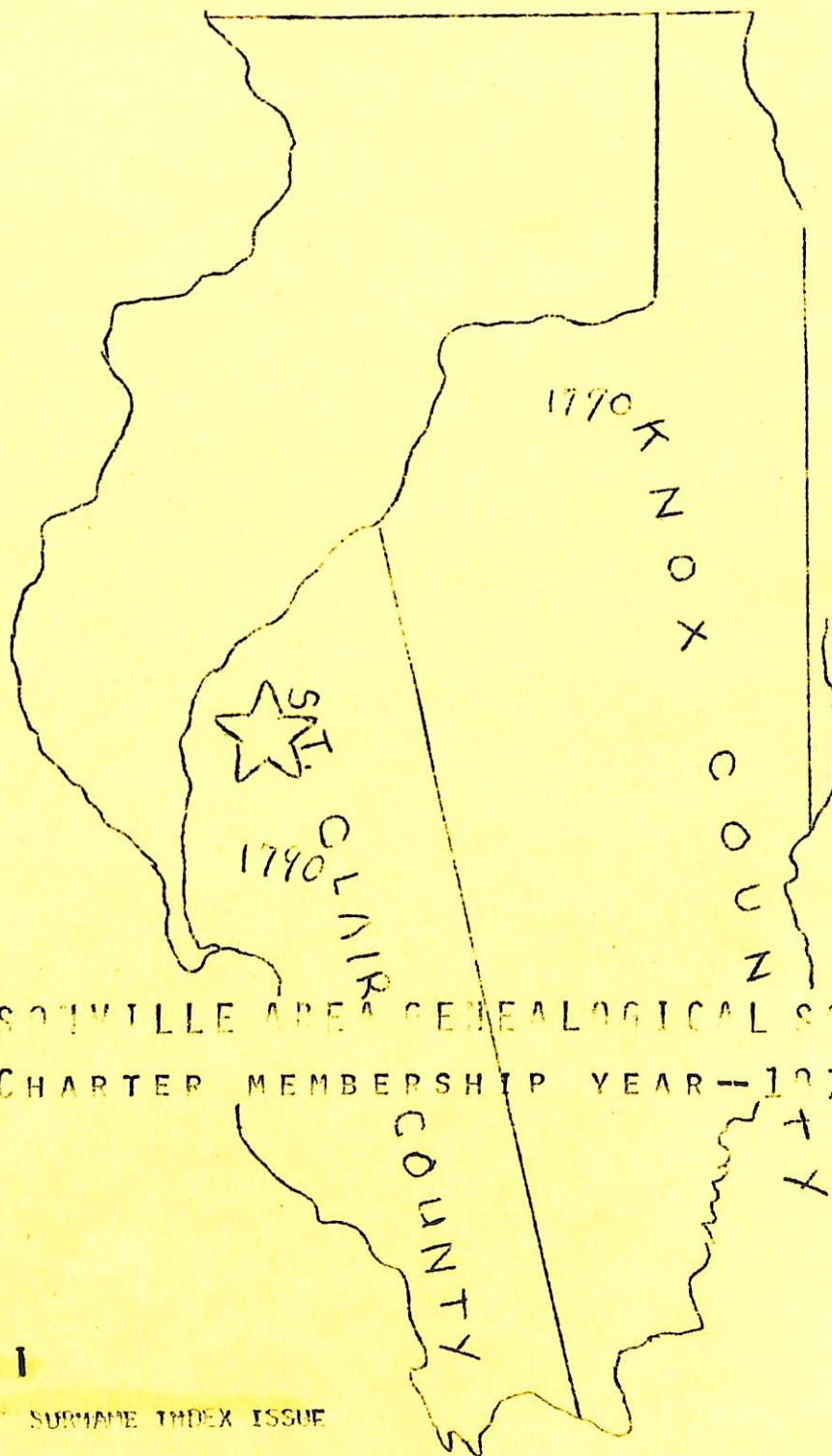

FOREWORD BY THE PRESIDENT

The reader should not consider the foregoing Surname Index as an accurate record of birth, death, or marriage of any individual because of the chance of error in transcribing so many names, without adequate methods, or time, to proof-read.

We hope we have many Divine Readers!

The purpose of this Surname Index, and the first publication of the Jacksonville Area Genealogical Society, is to establish lines of communication between genealogists who discover they are working on the same lineage, or collateral lines.

It was a group of very busy people who took time from regular duties to complete some part of the many processes required to publish this booklet. Information from the member's data sheet had to be interpreted, and transferred to index cards, so that surnames could be alphabetized. Several persons typed the stencils, and the sheets were finally run through a mimeograph. Others set up an assembly line to staple the thousands of sheets together in proper order (we hope).

Until a person has been involved in an extensive operation of this kind, he cannot conceive of the hours and days of preparation that has gone into the making of booklets, such as this one, compiled by the Genealogical Societies.

But those who devoted this time, consider it a Labor of Love in the hopes that some family-history seeker may benefit from its contents. Since WE are passing this information to YOU, will YOU also pass it on to OTHERS, by making this Surname Index available whenever possible to other individuals, or groups. Maybe you can carry it along to other organization meetings and let some of your friends "sneak a peek".
