I will participate as a: ___ Full Season Vendor (\$260) ___ Half Season Vendor (\$130/14 weeks) ___ Daily Vendor (\$20/day). If half season vendors attend beyond 14 weeks there will be an additional \$10/week fee.

The stated Vendor Fees are per space. Each space is roughly the size of a parking space (10'x10'). Most spaces will be large enough to park your vehicle behind your vending space.

Maximum spaces for Full and Half Season Vendors is two. Two spaces for Daily Vendors will only be allowed if space is available (approval required by Friday of the market week) you plan to attend.

The Full and Half Season Vendor Fees are due by April 30th each year. The Daily Vendor Fee is due at market each Saturday you attend if you have not paid before then.

All fees are non-refundable even if the Vendor does not attend on a scheduled market day. This includes any early closing of the market due to inclement weather or any other unforeseen emergency situation.

The Market Manager contacts all vendors by email on Wednesday each week asking them to confirm attendance for that week. Attendance must be confirmed by Friday morning to be included in the market newsletter and space assignments.

The Market Manager will send the vendor space assignment map on Friday evening.

If participating as a Half Season Vendor or a Daily Vendor, please circle the dates (if known) you plan to attend the Bedford Farmers Market.
