I will participate as a: ____ Full Season Vendor (\$260) ____ Half Season Vendor (\$150/12 weeks) ____ Daily Vendor (\$20/day). If Half Season vendors attend beyond 12 weeks there will be an additional \$20/week fee. The total fee must be paid in full before the first market to receive the rates listed above. If a Vendor cannot pay their full fee up front, they will be considered a daily vendor and pay \$20/market they attend.

The stated Vendor Fees are per space. Each space is roughly the size of a parking space (10'x10'). Most spaces will be large enough to park your vehicle behind your vending space.

Maximum spaces for Full and Half Season Vendors is two. Daily Vendors are limited to one space.

The Full and Half Season Vendor Fees are due by April 30th each year. The Daily Vendor Fee is due at market each Saturday you attend if you have not paid before then.

All fees are non-refundable even if the Vendor does not attend on a scheduled market day. This includes any early closing of the market due to inclement weather or any other unforeseen emergency situation.

The Market Manager contacts all vendors by email on Wednesday each week asking them to confirm attendance for that week. Attendance must be confirmed by Thursday evening to be included in the market newsletter and space assignments. The Market Manager will send the vendor space assignment map on Friday evening.

Food Assistance Programs

WIC Market Fresh and Senior Produce Fresh are now electronic programs requiring the vendor to have an agreement with the program and to receive reimbursement directly from WIC or Senior Produce Fresh. The market no longer collects vouchers or reimburses for these programs.

The Bedford Farmers Market is an authorized retailer for qualifying products in the following Food Assistance programs: SNAP, Double Up Food Bucks, and Vouchers for Veterans. Vendors with qualifying products are strongly encouraged to participate in these programs. Customers use SNAP benefits, DUFB tokens, or Vouchers for Veterans vouchers to purchase Vendor products and the Vendors are reimbursed by the Market. Contact the Market Manager with any questions or to request Vendor Agreements. Vendor Agreements for each program must be completed and returned with your Bedford Farmers Market agreement prior to participation in the market. It is the Vendor's responsibility to be familiar with the rules and qualified products for each program. Payment with program tokens or vouchers for non-qualifying products will not be reimbursed.

By signing below I agree to indemnify, hold harmless, release, waive, and forever discharge the Bedford Farmers Market, the Board of Directors, and the Lambertville United Methodist Church for all bodily and personal injury, including injuries resulting in death, and property damage, claims actions, damages, liabilities and expenses; including reasonable attorneys' fees and court costs, which may occur as a result of Vendor's participation in the Market, whether or not sounding in tort or contract, and whether or not caused by a negligent act or omission of the Market Board of Directors.
