# Week Two 8<sup>th</sup> July

- Pray for our **country.** At last, the country has the opportunity to move forward after a period of terrible decline. Pray that the people of our country will use their votes well and that a period of recovery can take place, not just in the everyday lives of the population but in the growth of respect for one another, for people with different or even opposite ideas.
- Over the next two weeks many schools will be breaking up for their summer holidays Pray that
  - 1. The pupils will be able to relax over the summer and recharge their batteries.
  - 2. That the teachers will also be able to relax and recover from the stress involved in meeting the governments targets and balancing that with providing education to suit all children.
  - 3. That the new schools minister will not seek to change things for change's sake.
  - 4. Pray for those leading summer schools, that their students will be safe and excited by the things they do.
- Pray for those **parents** seeking to do the best for their children during the summer. For those still working that the childcare they have to use will be a positive experience for their young ones and that when they go on holiday, if they can afford it, they will have a great time.

Week Three 15<sup>th</sup> July <u>Hebrews 13:8</u> Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever.

- Pray for those **researchers** trying to find new, cheap/free ways of producing and storing energy for heating, cooling and powering industry. Pray for governments round the world to encourage innovations such as the sand batteries being used in Finland. As the world gets hotter there will be a growing need for air conditioning and production of renewable fuels will need to be expanded to cater for this. Pray for the innovators who are looking at ways of solving the problems the earth will meet over the next 5 to 10 decades.
- Pray for the work of our circuit. The work done by our paid employees and that of our volunteers. Pray especially for our Methodist based charities -Action for Children (formerly NCH), LWPT - Leaders of Worship and Preachers Trust, LWP Homes, MHA – Housing and care for older people, Methodist Ministers Housing Society, All We Can (formerly Methodist relief and development fund) and MWiB – Methodist Women in Britain. All these charities seek to promote the Methodist church and its commitment to justice and equality.
- Pray for all those Christians working in **the music industry** that they can take the love of Christ into the workplace, whether in classical or pop culture. Pray especially for them to have the confidence to speak truth to the people they work with and the media that can be so influential. Pray for those who are so famous they have online followings that they may be true to the gospel of Christ in their communications with fans and with the music Industry in general.

# Week Four 22<sup>nd</sup> July

#### **Romans 13:8**

Let no debt remain outstanding, except the continuing debt to love one another, for whoever loves others has fulfilled the law.

- The African Union has made serious efforts in the last decade to develop a full-fledged architecture for the prevention and management of conflict, however, that is so far yet to produce tangible results. Its performance has continued to be mixed. Pray that the Union will develop further protocols to help prevent wars within the continent. The AU continues to struggle with inconsistent funding and resources (provided largely by the European Union), and political divisions and lack of political will among its member states. This situation has meant that mediators, often from outside of the region, who are part of the problem, have taken leading roles in conflicts like Sudan and Libya. Despite its elaborate structures aimed at peace-making, the African Union (AU) is clearly failing to end conflicts on the continent. Last month's annual <u>AU summit</u> in Addis Ababa should have been an opportunity for heads of state to tackle the many raging conflicts. Leaders at the event on February 17 and 18, 2024 said they were extremely concerned about the war in Sudan, armed groups threatening lives in the eastern Democratic Republic of the Congo (DRC) and jihadist violence in the Sahel. However, they made little progress.
- There are several factors behind this. One is the AU's institutional weakness. It is mired in bureaucracy and often doesn't have enough money to send mediators to conflict zones or pay extra staff for the AU's offices in various African capitals. Or else it has to wait for funding from donors, who often try to influence the AU's priorities. Another obstacle is competition between member states. Many don't agree on how to tackle conflicts or where the AU should be heading. And like the UN, the AU is an intergovernmental organization that can only take action on conflict when member states authorize it. Pray for a commitment to permanent peace throughout the African Union and not just when it suits individuals and parties involved in the conflicts.
- July 24<sup>th</sup> is National Schizophrenia Awareness Day. Pray for those services and charities that support people with this condition. Pray for the researchers trying to find new cures and to find out the causes of this condition. Doctors often describe schizophrenia as a type of pychosis This means the person may not always be able to distinguish their own thoughts and ideas from reality and as a result have hallucinations, muddled thought processes and delusions. Pray for the families of such people who often find themselves with no support as the mental health system in the UK is not currently fit for purpose.

# Week Five 29<sup>th</sup> July.

#### <u>1 John 3:11</u>

## For this is the message you heard from the beginning: We should love one another.

- Emergency Services. Pray for the emergency services that we so often rely on. The Ambulance Service, Mountain Rescue, Cave Rescue, Fire and Rescue, Police, Coast Guard and Lifeboat Association. Much of their work is done under great stress and often in conditions ordinary people would be unable to cope with. Pray especially this week for the Coast Guard service, working to keep our coasts safe but often vilified for its work and actions over asylum seekers and boats. Their National Day is August 4<sup>th</sup>. Pray especially for Mountain Rescue, Cave Rescue, National Lifeboats and Air Ambulances as these services are funded by donation not the government
- National Immunisation awareness month. This month is designed to highlight the need for children and young people to be immunized against both childhood and adult diseases that can threaten to end or alter life chances and expectancies. After the tragic cases of autism being blamed on vaccines and the ridiculous scare stories and conspiracy theories on the internet, the level of immunity for many formerly common diseases has fallen and we are seeing the impact in rising cases of such things as measles and whooping cough. Pray for parents to receive the right advice so their children can be protected against these diseases.
- Pray for all those volunteers around the country organising and staffing fetes, barbeques, open arts, open gardens and other fundraising events for charities throughout the UK. Many charities rely on these events too be able to continue working and helping their local communities.
