Hello everyone and welcome to the FC HOG 2022.



Safety Officer News

Check out the tips to get your bike ready for your ride.

It's time... to get your motorcycle ready for spring.



FUEL SYSTEM

Drain and replace old fuel if not stabilized before winter

AIR FILTER

Remove any debris and



replace the filter if it is dirty



Check tire pressure and tread wear



DRIVE TRAIN

Look over the sprockets and chain for any wear. Clean the chain and lubricate it



ENGINE FLUIDS

Change the oil and filter and check coolant levels



BRAKES

Check brake fluid levels and brake pad wear



BATTERY

Charge battery



LIGHTS, CABLES & FASTENERS

Test all lights: confirm the throttle, clutch and brake cables operate smoothly. Tighten any loose fasteners
