

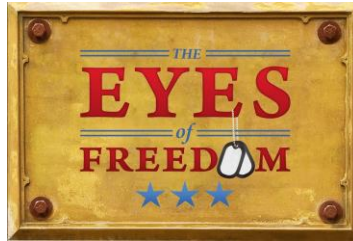


THE EYES OF FREEDOM: LIMA COMPANY MEMORIAL

HOSTING GUIDELINES

Thank you for your interest in becoming a host for this remarkable exhibit. Please read the guidelines below and contact us if you have any questions. If you would like to apply to host The Eyes of Freedom Memorial, please fill out an application on the following pages and send it to us as instructed below. 1. Security – The Exhibits requires a secure environment, not only to honor the memory of our heroes, but also to ensure it is safe from vandalism and theft. Our staff needs to know your surveillance plans.
2. Space Requirements – There are 8 panels each measuring 6' wide x 9' tall x 4' deep. In order to have at least 3 feet between and around each panel, the Memorial needs to be displayed in spaces with a minimum of 40' x 40' or 20' x 60' elongated. Space is also required for our 3 interactive kiosks, each 96" tall, 4' deep, two at 70" wide, and one at 52" wide. Silent Battle, our bronze sculpture, sits on a 5' diameter octagonal metal base and is about 4' tall. Please speak with our staff for guidance. In addition, a place is needed to display the 42' Eyes of Freedom trailer.
3. Venue Options – These include college student unions, state capitol buildings, local government buildings, county fairgrounds, art galleries, and High School gymnasiums, among many others.
4. Lighting – If your building/enclosure is not equipped with proper lighting, we ask that you provide extra lighting for these special paintings. Lighting is required for evening viewing hours.
5. Admission Fees – There is no fee for the public to see this Memorial at your event. If your event charges admission, there will be no additional charge to view The Eyes of Freedom exhibits.
6. Volunteers – 12-15 able bodied volunteers are required to assist for set up and take down. Eyes of Freedom does NOT provide physical labor. The Eyes of Freedom Team will guide and direct your volunteers to assemble and take down the exhibit.
7. Set Up – The exhibit gets set up the day or evening before the public display begins.
8. Entrance – If no loading dock exists at your venue, double doors leading to the display must have dividers removed.
9. Signage – Identifying signs provided by The Eyes of Freedom must be prominently displayed.
10. Donations – Please direct individual donors to our website (www.EyesOfFreedom.org) or provide our Eyes of Freedom address: PO Box 30288, Columbus, Ohio 43230. We are a 501(C) 3 organization incorporated in the State of Ohio and all donations are tax deductible. *You agree, by hosting us at your event, that we can openly solicit donations.* Additionally, Eyes of Freedom merchandise is available for purchase during all display hours.
11. Cost – The host agrees to pay for displaying The Eyes of Freedom exhibits according to the Contract to be signed by both the host and The Eyes of Freedom staff. (See the hosting brief for more details on what is included.)
