- A panel of distinguished tastetesters will judge all samples on Monday Morning, February 10th at the conference. The winner will be announced at the conference Awards Reception on Tuesday, February 11th starting at 3:30 PM.
- 3 Judging Criteria: Taste, Bouquet and Clarity
- 4 The winner will be eligible to compete against other states at the National Rural Water Association's Rural Water Rally in Washington, D.C. in February 2026. IRWA will award the Best Tasting Water winner a trip to the Water Rally with two nights of accommodation and airfare for one individual from that utility. All other expenses are the responsibility of the Water Rally attendee(s).
- **5** Contest is open to lowa communities and regional systems.

REGISTRATION/CANCELLATION POLICY

All conference participants must register.
