Bank Holidays

Answer:

Employees who are usually entitled to take bank holidays as holidays (i.e they don't normally work them) are able to take these as leave whilst on furlough unless a separate agreement has been reached.

Therefore for employees who are normally off on a bank holiday, they should be paid 100% pay for that day.

For employees who would normally work the bank holiday, their accrual continues as normal and they can be paid the usual furlough rate.
