At the November meeting, the budget was reviewed and approved. Also approved was a rate increase for 2020. The system improvement fee will increase by \$2.50. The 0 to 3000 gallon usage tier will increase by 5 cents per 100 gallons. The 3000 to 6000 usage tier will increase by 15 cents per hundred gallons. The MIL levy will decrease.
