Old Business:

- * Covenant Publication. Gabi has received six requests for copies of the covenants. She will bring survey results and a rough draft from the previous attempt at revision to the next Board meeting. There ensued a discussion about the purpose or goals in revising the covenants. Are they of historical interest only? Will there be a real impact on the community if they reflect current land use and recommendations for such issues as fire mitigation? Will revisit next Meeting.
- * Joan shared information from the Larimer County website regarding anonymous complaints. Must be written and signed unless it is a life safety issue OR has significant impact on the public, nearby property, or the neighborhood.
- * Dry Hydrant parts are all here. Elliott will arrange for draining Crescent Lake, required excavation, and installation.
- * Resiliency Meeting with Larimer County for emergency planning in mountain communities. Dianna suggested we might consider an educational tool, such as what to do if, be written and shared with the community.
- * Colorado Cherry Company attempt to rezone. Some present have heard that it has already essentially been approved, others that it has not. We await communication from Larimer County to Property Owners.

Treasurers Report: \$14,277.46 on hand, with bills of \$782.62 for dry hydrant supplies, or \$13,494.84.

Membership stands at 217 of about 430 homes.

Member Issues: It was requested that Gabi include etiquette and tips for winter driving in the next newsletter, such as use of sand barrels and right of way to uphill traffic. She will do so.
