New Business:

- Customer Packet Renewal- Joan presented the first draft of a Newcomers Flier. Suggestions were given by all present. Joan will revise. She continues to work on the Welcome Packet revision.
- Bobcat killing- Joan will re-contact Colorado Parks and Wildlife to seek a form for reporting violations. We agreed that we probably do not have sufficient documentation of the recent incident to submit a formal complaint, but having the form will educate us on what is required to report any further incident.
- Fourth of July Parade and Potluck- Gabi will submit a request in the Newsletter for volunteers to organize a Potluck. Dianna will be the contact person. Flags purchased last year are in the file cabinet at the Fire Station.
- Dianna suggested requesting a class from the Fire Chief to educate residents about dangers driving up the canyon from Lyons, including specific trouble spots. Gabi will contact the Chief.

Old Business:

- Bear and Mountain Lion Education- No update.
- Map- Gabi has updated the PWS/EPE map with addresses; Patty Rolfe will complete the revision.
- Dead Tree- The chainsaw artist who has been contacted needs a scaffold to work above 11 ft. Gabi will price rental cost. The artist will be here in about two weeks to evaluate the job and provide drawings. Jeff Foreman has requested that the project includes a memorial to his sons, Daniel and Jacob. Current plans call for a spiral scroll with history of PWS and a variety of local animals to be carved. Joan will contact Gary Clements to obtain historical documents to inform the inscription.

- Spring Clean-up- Dianna will contact Bryan Baer about renting/borrowing his commercial chipper-shredder for the PSPOA, and perhaps Fire and Water Boards, to coordinate a community-wide fire mitigation project.
