- Cherry Company. Eleven residents came to voice their outrage at the decision of the Larimer County Board of Commissioners to permit 7 more wedding events this summer after 30 people attended two meetings in Fort Collins to protest the Mon Cheri application. 28 spoke against the application at those meetings, and the two who spoke in favor benefit financially from Mon Cheri events. Dan Grotke volunteered to meet with Jonathan Hummel, lawyer, whom Gabi will contact, and asked that as many of the attendees as possible join them. There are several offers of financial assist for legal help. There are 30 days in which to file an appeal, starting from June 11. The form is on line at Larimer County.
