It is also Preble Meadow Jumping Mouse habitat. The reservoir is not open for public use. That includes fishing, boating, swimming or just splashing around.

We have located and repaired several small leaks in our system, however we are still looking for the big one. Please help us by reporting any running or standing water you might encounter while out walking or working in your yard.
