Do you know where your whole house shut off valve is located? Many residents don't even know they have one. If it is not in an easily accessible location, have a plumber relocate it. Whole house shut off valves are used to turn off the water to your whole house during an emergency or to turn off water to your home while you are away for more than a few days. Locate yours (somewhere inside your home) make sure it doesn't leak and is easily accessible.

Planning to burn slash on your property? You must have a valid burn permit issued by Larimer County and signed by the Pinewood Springs Fire Department. Apply online on the Larimer County website [larimer.org](http://larimer.org) where you will also find the information you need to burn slash piles safely. Each year our volunteer firefighters respond to chimney fires. Make it a habit to have your chimney cleaned each Fall prior to regular use. A chimney sweep is much less expensive than fire or smoke damage.
