The February 1st bill reflects the new rates for 2021. The Base rate has increased to \$59.50; the system improvement fee is now \$28.50; usage from 0 to 3000 gallons is billed at \$.70 per 100 gallons; the 3000 to 6000 tier is billed at \$1.40 per 100 gallons; anything over 6000 gallons is billed at \$6.00 per 100 gallons. The new tap fee for 2021 is \$45,830.75.

When cleaning ashes from your fireplace or wood stove, put them in a metal container with a lid and place the container away from your home and away from any combustible materials. For further safety, you may add water to the container and stir. When the ashes are cold to the touch (usually after 1 week), they may be disposed of.
