Planning Committee Update

Old Business

The library would like to know if we can come up with a place where they might be able to put a sign directing people to where the library is located. The Village ordinance states no more than two signs on one parcel of land, so President Marilyn Cousineau is leaving it up to the council. The council suggested a sign on Main St and 131 as well as Thumblake and Railroad St. If they can get approval from the state, then the signs can be put up, tabled until the next meeting.

New Business

The Street that runs past Cedar Street, where it goes up the hill, has been renamed by the assessor as Mountain Side Trail. He has changed 69 addresses so far.

MEC Underground Solution gave a bid of \$4800 to do work to meet the CDSMI requirement. Brandy Marvin made a motion to have the work done to meet the CDSMI requirement by October 21, 2024, the motion was supported by Doug Weiss. Motion carried to all in favor.

There was a discussion on the Travel Trailer Ordinance. Marilyn will send a letter to Peter Wendling to see if the ordinance is legal.
