VILLAGE OF BOYNE FALLS MUNICIPAL CIVIL INFRACTION FINE ORDINANCE Ordinance No. 47

THE VILLAGE OF BOYNE FALLS ORDAINS:

Section 1. Municipal Civil Infraction Fines.

The fines for violations of present and future ordinances of the Village of Boyne Falls for which violations are designated municipal civil infractions as defined in Public Act 12 of 1994, amending Public Act 236 of 1961, being Sections 600.101–600.9939 of Michigan Compiled Laws shall be punished as follows:

- (a). For a first offense, a person found responsible shall be fined no more than \$100.00, plus costs of prosecution.
- (b). For a second violation of the same ordinance provision within one (1) year, a person found responsible shall be fined not less than \$100.00 nor more than \$250.00, plus costs of prosecution.
- (c). For a third or subsequent violation of the same ordinance provision within two (2) years, a person found responsible shall be fined not less than \$250.00 nor more than \$500.00, plus costs of prosecution.

Section 2. Effective Date.

This Ordinance shall become effective thirty (30) days after being published in a newspaper of general circulation within the Village.
