

VILLAGE OF BOYNE FALLS QUARTERLY NEWS

The Village of Boyne Falls effective April 1, 2024 will start charging a 3% fee to use credit cards to pay water bills and any other items such as permit fees and taxes.

This November is the election year for Village Trustees and President. If you are interested in running for a position you will need to file an Affidavit of Identity and a nonpartisan nominating petition by Tuesday, July 23, 2024 at 4:00PM. The petitions should have a minimum of 6 and a maximum of 20 signatures. You can pick up the Petitions and Affidavits at Boyne Valley Township office located on the corner of Railroad and Mill Street. If you are interested in making a difference in our Village please consider running. You must be a resident of the Village and a registered voter.

Boyne Falls Planning committee meets on the second Monday of the Month at 6:00 PM we welcome input from residents of the Boyne Falls area.
