# New Man Refresher

What is one major thing that you remember from the new man?

- As he is so am I.
- The old things have already gone and the new things has come.
- All the new things are coming only from God.
- We have the mind of Christ.
- There is no one on earth with more authority than us.
- Christ in us the hope of glory.
- Our oneness with Christ, never leaving us or forsaking us.
- The devil is under our feet and all his workers.
- We are partakers with his divine nature.
- Spirt, soul and body. We are Spirit. We have a soul and live in a body. That is a gamechanger.
- I am crucified with Christ, raised with him, and seated with him, next to God's right hand in Christ Jesus.
- We are walking in the Spirit.
- The new man is because the new covenant who God made with him in Jesus.
- We don't have to live in sin conscious because he paid everything for us.
- The understanding of reality and truth.
- I am a son of God. I am a servant of my neighbour and I am the devil's master.
- We have to put on the new man.
- There is no condemnation for us.

Amen condemnation is the devil's big gun. That is what you would call the devils bazooka. If he can get believers condemned and feeling guilty and unworthy, he has a mighty victory over them.

- We are a new creation and old things have passed away.
- We were dead but now we are alive. What we lost in Adam we receive back in the new man.

We are going to do a refresher today. A recap and some points that I want to highlight.

When we talk about the new man we are talking about the new creation.

Some people call it NCR - New creation realities or ICR - In Christ realities.

A theological term to this is Paul's revelations. That is where you are going to discover the teaching on the new man and the new creation.

Why is this message important? You will never be a manifested son of God unless you are established in the new creation. You can't manifest something that you don't know if it exists. So, you have to know that you are a new creation and then you can manifest as a new creation. Why is it important? Those of you that are discipling people, must spend the vast majority of your time discipling them in the new creation realities. If you want fans then just preach what you want to preach but if you want solid disciples you have to teach the new creation, the revelation of Paul. This is where you form strong believers.

Let's build a strong foundation on the new creation, the new man and why the message is important. We can't be manifested sons of God without the revelation of Paul.

#### John 16:12-16

I have yet many things to say unto you, but ye cannot bear them now. Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come. He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you. All things that the Father hath are mine: therefore said I, that he shall take of mine, and shall shew it unto you. A little while, and ye shall not see me: and again, a little while, and ye shall see me, because I go to the Father.

#### **Pauls Gospel**

Notice v12. Jesus is speaking. He says that "There are things that I want to show you but right now you can't bare them." The reason they couldn't bear them is because they weren't born again. 1 Corinthians 2:14 says spiritual things are spiritually discerned.

He said when the Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he speak: and he will shew you things to come.

#### John 16:14

He shall glorify me: for he shall receive of mine, and shall shew it unto you.

This is foundations. There were things that Jesus wanted to say but didn't and then the Spirit came and then revealed those things and revealed those things to his disciples. There are some things that Jesus wanted to say but didn't say. That has to be clear and those things were revealed to the apostle Paul.

This is such an important message. The problems that we have in the world, a major part of that is lack of identity. You don't know whether you are coming or going. Strong delusion. The majority of problems in the church are also because a lack of identity. If we can solve this identity problem then the church as a whole can start doing what God has called them to do.

Galatians 1:1-12
Paul, an apostle, (not of men, neither by man, but by Jesus Christ, and God the Father,
who raised him from the dead;)
And all the brethren which are with me, unto the churches of Galatia:
Grace be to you and peace from God the Father, and from our Lord Jesus Christ,
Who gave himself for our sins, that he might deliver us from this present evil world,
according to the will of God and our Father:
To whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen.
I marvel that ye are so soon removed from him that called you into the grace of Christ
unto another gospel:
Which is not another; but there be some that trouble you, and would pervert the gospel
of Christ.
But though we, or an angel from heaven, preach any other gospel unto you than that
which we have preached unto you, let him be accursed.

As we said before, so say I now again, If any man preach any other gospel unto you than that ye have received, let him be accursed. For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ. But I certify you, brethren, that the gospel which was preached of me is not after man. For I neither received it of man, neither was I taught it, but by the revelation of Jesus Christ.

I think that is quite strong. He said "If you preach any other gospel let him be accursed" and then he said this is the gospel that I preach to you and he said that this gospel he didn't receive from man but from revelation from God. You know that Paul he wasn't there with the 12; he Got saved on the road to Damascus. He didn't spend time with Jesus during his earth ministry. He said that this revelation came directly from God.

# <mark>Ephesians 3:1-9</mark>

For this cause I Paul, the prisoner of Jesus Christ for you Gentiles,

If ye have heard of the dispensation of the grace of God which is given me to you-ward: How that by revelation he made known unto me the mystery; (as I wrote afore in few words,

Whereby, when ye read, ye may understand my knowledge in the mystery of Christ) Which in other ages was not made known unto the sons of men, as it is now revealed unto his holy apostles and prophets by the Spirit;

That the Gentiles should be fellowheirs, and of the same body, and partakers of his promise in Christ by the gospel:

Whereof I was made a minister, according to the gift of the grace of God given unto me by the effectual working of his power.

Unto me, who am less than the least of all saints, is this grace given, that I should preach among the Gentiles the unsearchable riches of Christ;

And to make all men see what is the fellowship of the mystery, which from the beginning of the world hath been hid in God, who created all things by Jesus Christ:

You can see that this came by revelation. He said the mystery has been revealed. The secret has been revealed. It was hidden and has now been revealed.

There is something else when we are reading the letters of Paul; he uses the term "my gospel." Paul received what he knew by revelation, by the Spirit of God, it was a mystery that has been revealed. It was a secret that has now been opened.

Romans 2:16

In the day when God shall judge the secrets of men by Jesus Christ according to my gospel.

According to my gospel. Everyone say "According to my gospel." This gospel that Paul was preaching he got it directly from God by the spirit and he is making a distinction between other gospels and this one.

### Romans 16:25

Now to him that is of power to stablish you according to my gospel, and the preaching of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery, which was kept secret since the world began,

Amen. You will never be established the way that God wants you to absent of the revelation of Paul. P C Nelson, the assemblies of God bible scholar said "No great preacher has risen to bless the people of God that has not lighted his torch at the flame kindled by Paul."

He is saying that prominent powerful preachers are so because they have received something from the apostle Paul.

Why is it important? Because we want to grow into Christ. We want to be established, we want to be manifested sons of God and the only way is through the writings of Paul. You will not be established reading the Old Testament. You won't even be established reading the gospels. Not even the book of acts. You can only be established by the books of Paul.

The Old Testament was primarily written to the Jews. Someone says "I want to make a sacrifice" well is your name Abraham? It was written to the Jews. It surprises how you have no Jewish ancestry and yet you want to act like a Jew.

The gospel was written to the world. In John's gospel it says that these things were writings you may believe. The four gospels were written to the world. The letters of Paul are direct letters to the church. You should spend the majority of your time in the letters of Paul. Smith Wigglesworth said that "Pauls letters are God's latest revelation."

In the gospels it is a proclamation of the gospel. The book of acts is a demonstration of the gospel. The writings of Paul are an explanation of the gospel. The four gospels Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John show us what happened to Christ. He came, he lived, he healed, he blessed, discipled, was crucified, went in a tomb, came out the tomb and was taken to heaven.

Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John show us what happened to Christ and the letters of Paul show us what happened in Christ. The four gospels are a picture the letters of Paul are an x ray. The four gospels show us what happened to Jesus in the physical realm. The writing of Paul reveals to us what happened in the spirt realm.

For us to be established the way that God wants us to and to manifest we have to light our torch at the flame that is kindled by Paul. You will never discover who you are by just reading the four gospels. You will never know who you are by reading the old covenant. The only way you can know who you are and what you have and how God sees you is through the writings of the apostle of Paul. They should be highly marked in your bible. It always troubles me when I read through someone's bible and the only place that is marked is job. if I am sitting down with someone, I automatically pick up someone's bible and start going through it. For us to know who we are we only find ourselves in the letters of Paul and we should be spending the majority of the time in his writings. Jesus said there are many things that he wanted to say and when the spirit of truth comes, he will guide you and reveal to you the Holy Spirit revealed these truths to Paul

The letters of Paul contain the truths of Jesus that were un uttered. The writings of Paul are also red letters.

1 Corinthians 14:37 If any man think himself to be a prophet, or spiritual, let him acknowledge that the things that I write unto you are the commandments of the Lord.

The things I am writing to you are the things that Jesus is saying to you.

1 Thessalonians 2:13

For this cause also thank we God without ceasing, because, when ye received the word of God which ye heard of us, ye received it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which effectually worketh also in you that believe.

This is a game changer. This will revolutionise your life. Paul is saying "My writings are the words of God." Do you hear people today? I get accused of it all the time. "You are Pauls followers I listen to Jesus." They accuse us of being Pauls followers. He is saying that his writings are the word of God. watch this, Paul's revelation is Jesus latest teachings.

# <mark>2 Peter 3:15 - 16</mark>

And account that the longsuffering of our Lord is salvation; even as our beloved brother Paul also according to the wisdom given unto him hath written unto you; As also in all his epistles, speaking in them of these things; in which are some things hard to be understood, which they that are unlearned and unstable wrest, as they do also the other scriptures, unto their own destruction.

Peter is saying that "Paul is writing these letters and even I am finding theme hard to understand." Peter is comparing the writings of Paul as scripture. There were many things that Jesus wanted to say and didn't say and ended up saying them through the apostle of Paul. Watch this, like I said the Old Testament was written to Jews. The four gospels were written to the world and the letters of Paul are written directly to the body of Christ's to discover what we have and what we can do. Jesus our substitute. Matthew Mark Luke and John don't show you our sin coming upon him and him becoming our substitute and redeeming us. They just show us what happened to Christ but Paul unreaps what was happening in Christ.

The gospel shows us what was happening in the Spirit realm how we were being legally redeemed, We were being purchased.

We will not be established without the gospel of Paul. What am I saying? You should spend the majority of your time in the letters of Paul. You are disciplining others into the revelation of Paul.

#### What Pauls revelation contain

# 1 The Revelation Of The Grace Of God

God's grace how it is completely unmerited favour and ability that has made this possible. It is the grace of God and not the works of men. We would have all fallen short if it was the works of men. Everything you are and can have is because of the grace of God. in the writings of Paul, he addresses personal issues in the church btu he always brings them back to who they are in Christ. In the Old Testament you did Holy to become Holy. in the New Testament you've become Holy so now you can do Holy. it is the concept of grace and it is living from the inside out. so, the Old Testament it was works that justified you. in the New Testament because you are justified you work.

Paul's revelation is the concept of the grace of God

John g lake said, "the secret of heavens power is not in the doing. But in the being." How many would agree that this guy knew a few things. he emptied hospitals. He might have some insight into this. the bible says be Holy for I am Holy. it doesn't say d holy to be Holy. he has made Holy and because he has made us Holy, we can do Holy. because we are forgiven, we can forgive because we are loved we can love. This is Paul's revelation on the grace of God

### 2 Man Is A Spirit Being

He has a soul and lives in a body and our connection with God is Spirit to Spirit. Not soul, not body to Spirit, Spirit to Spirit. God is the Father of spirits. That is a truth that we have to look into.

#### 3 Man Was In Adam

We were identified with Adam and were suffering the consequences of Adam. Man was in Adam. This is only brought out in the writings of Paul.

### 4 Jesus in his death burial resurrection and ascension was our substitute.

Say "He was our substitute." In other words, say "He took my place. He suffered on my behalf." This concept is only found in the writings of Paul, the substitution. We can write *the substitution and exchange*. That means he took my sin and gave me his righteousness. He took my sicknesses and my pain and gave me his healing and health. He became like me, so I could become like him. That is substitution and exchange.

### 5 Jesus is Lord

He is master, he is Lord of all.

### 6 Now We Become One With Christ

### 7 We Live From The Inside Out

It is your inward reality that changes the outward circumstances.

You need to do a deep study into the writings of Paul. Book by book you will discover who you are, what you have, what you can do. You will discover what Jesus did and what he doing now at the right hand of the Father. Jesus completely identified with us. Over and over, he referred to himself as the son of man. The Son of God became a son of man so the sons of men can become the sons of God. He identified with us; we must now identify with him. Let me ask you. How many on the call believe everything that God has said about himself? If you believe everything that God has said about himself you must also believe everything that he said about you. Many believe what God said about himself but doubt what God has said about them. It is only through the letters of Paul that we discover this. How does God see me and you? How does he see us? In Jesus; Identical to Jesus.

This is why we need to spend the majority of our time in the letters of Paul. Letting the Holy Spirit reveal to you -you. Show you what you have become and whose you are.

Hold up your hands. Whoever needs healing should be healed right now. Look at all these hands. 1 2 3 be free now.

Take this hand and say "This hand is Jesus," say "With his life, with his power, with his ability with his wisdom, with his peace everything he is." Let's see your other hand, say "This is me" Bring your hands together and interlock your fingers. "In Christ we become one"

# Us In Christ, Christ In Us

You only have in you what Christ has in him. If it's not in Christ, it is not in you. If you think that it's in you then you haven't yet read the letters of Paul to show you what is in you because Pauls letters reveal that we have become one with him. Everything that is in Jesus is now in me. That is our union. That special word, *In Christ*. Pauls letters in Christ. Our union with him "I am united in Christ the way I was united in Adam" Listen I first came into this truth around in 1997. I got glimpses of this, and then

this really kicked in, this revelation. I was asked to teach a new man seminar, Chris had booked it and he couldn't do it and then I was teaching and then this revelation was like light bulbs, flashes. Life going into me. I was awake all night and then teaching in the day.

So, this really became truth to me about 2015 and I am still growing and that is where I spend most of my time. After I meet Jesus the second person, I want to see is Paul and then I will see my grandmother. There is something about Paul that excites me. He was like a robot. Like the terminator. He would get knocked down and get back up. It was this revelation in him. Not with the Nazareth Christ but with the risen Christ. What a life, what a legacy. He lived this revelation and he is living proof that this revelation works. You know in one place in the bible you read all the bad things he did in the book of acts. In one place in the bible, he says that he "has wronged no man" and you think what happened? We know what your life was like, you were persecuting and then he said that he did no man wrong. His past was gone, finished. He was alive in Christ. You will only see this in the letters of Paul. This is where we need to be established and see ourselves as God sees us. This is the primary work of the Holy Spirit. To reveal you to you. Every day the Holy Spirit is revealing who you really are. Not who you are going to be but who you are already. God is not going to save anybody. you say Lord please save my aunty; she needs to be saved. Why do you ask this because he has already saved her, now she needs to believe and receive and then that comes into play.

God isn't going to heal anyone; he has already healed once you believe that you receive it becomes a living reality for you.

We say that "God isn't finished with me yet." My friend, God was finished with you 2 years ago. You have become God's masterpiece. Once you believe and receive it become a reality in your life.

I know it's a nice saying to say that "God isn't finished with us" Listen God is finished the work is done our job is to believe and receive.

- Say "I am a believer. Not a doubter
- I am a believer and not a feeler
- I am a believer not a doubter
- I am a believer not a feeler
- I believe God's word above what I can feel or see
- God said it I believe it that settles it
- I don't need your confirmation the word of God is enough"

Are we going to believe what God says about us? Are we going to live according the labels of the world and what the devil puts on us? Are you going to believe that you're as clean as Jesus? You are as clean as Jesus Christ. As Holy as Christ. As righteous as Jesus Christ. As strong as Jesus Christ. This comes back to as he is so are we in this world.

That is a good place to smile and say "Hallelujah."

We have to spend the majority of our time mediating on the rights of Paul. You will never appreciate Jesus without the writings of Paul. It isn't just that he died on the cross. It was that he was separated from the father so that me and you can be united with The Father. See yourself this way. See yourself as the light of the world. When you are established in this: your tone will be different, your walk will be different, your love for others will be different.

We carry God. God in a man, Jesus Christ. God in me and you - Christians. God was in a man - Jesus Christ. T L Osborn said "God in a Jew, now, God in me and you." We are as much an incarnation of Jesus; we are as much an incarnation on this planet as Jesus was when he walked the shores of Galilee. We have to see that we have been born of the same mould of Jesus Christ. He is the first born. Say "I am the light of the world. I am the salt of the world."

Do you know that you carry God? You are God manifested in the flesh today. Sorry if that troubles your religious ways. Pray about it.

Me and Mira were in T K Maxx and this caught me off guard; this guy walked past me and growled at me. I wasn't really expecting it and it caught me off guard and then he went and I told Mira and as I was talking to her it reminded me that they recognised Jesus and they said "Have you come here to torment us." I thought it was strange. It's a bit out the normal. You just looking at some clothes and then someone comes and growls. It was only when I realised what happened; the spirit in the man recognised the Spirit in me. I am one spirit with Jesus. That will not happen again, someone growling at me and getting away with it. Even if the isles have to close and security have to come. Devils recognise you; they said Jesus we know, Paul we know. You we know.

Say this with me "I am one Spirit with him. If they recognised him, they recognise me." You will only find that in the writings of Paul.

# How can this now start becoming a reality in our lives?

Go into the book, meditate, find out where you are. Terms like in Christ: in him, in him whom, by whom, these are all saying the same thing. They are all speaking of our union with Christ. Underline and meditate. Start from the book of Romans, and work your way through the letters of Paul. This is something that has already happened. Not going to happened.

Ephesians 1:1 Paul, an apostle of Jesus Christ by the will of God, to the saints which are at Ephesus, and to the faithful <u>in Christ</u> Jesus:

In Christ.

Ephesians 1:2-3 Grace be to you, and peace, from God our Father, and from the Lord Jesus Christ. Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who hath blessed us with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places <u>in Christ</u>:

Are you in Christ? If you are in Christ you are blessed with every spiritual blessing. If you are in union with Christ you are blessed with every spiritual blessing so technically you can not be any more blessed. Let me admit that I am guilty of it, I still say God bless you when someone sneezes but biblically the believer in Christ can not be any more blessed. We have the majority of the church running around trying to get blessed. That is an identity problem. Say with me. "I am in Christ and I am blessed with every spiritual blessing." Watch this to say that you are not blessed is to also say that you are not in Christ.

#### Ephesians 1:4

According as he hath chosen us <u>in him</u> before the foundation of the world, that we should be holy and without blame before him in love:

That word again, in him. In Christ. In union. We are blessed in him and we are chosen in him. That should bring your shoulders back, a bounce in your step. A Bob Marley walk. You are chosen in him and it doesn't matter who rejects you. You are not going to worry who rejects you when he has chosen you. Also, I am not looking for acceptance.

Right now, we are chosen and we are Holy and without blame before him in love.

Say "I am Holy, In his holiness, My holiness falls short, that is why we need his holiness. He makes us Holy so that we can live Holy." We have taught a reverse in the church. Live Holy and do Holy and then you become Holy. God's economy is different. God has made us Holy and because we are made Holy, we can live Holy. Holy and without blame.

Ephesians 1:5 Having predestinated us unto the adoption of children by Jesus Christ to himself, according to the good pleasure of his will,

We are predestined to be conformed to the image of Jesus Christ. God has predestined you. preplanned that we should be conformed into that image

Ephesians 1:6 To the praise of the glory of his grace, wherein he hath made us accepted <u>in the beloved</u>.

Say "I am blessed. I am chosen, I am Holy, I am without blame, I am predestinated, I am accepted. He has accepted us." Doesn't that make you feel good? That means I don't need to beg and plead and fight to be accepted. I am already accepted in Christ. Love me or hate me that is your problem. I love you still but I am accepted in Christ. I am not looking for acceptance now because I have already been accepted. These are in Christ realities. These are the writings of Paul. You are chosen, blessed pre destined.

Ephesians 1:7 <u>In whom</u> we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of his grace;

We are legally redeemed, no longer a slave of the devil and there has been a legal purchase for my freedom. The chains have come off. I am no longer a slave in sin. I am a son in the family. We have redemption. Not we are going to get redemption. You know how much redemption you have? As much as Jesus. You are as free as Jesus Christ. This will do something in you if you keep thinking and talking like this.

The word forgiveness is remission. A total wiping away of our sin. No memory of our sin. This is why when you talk to God and you say "You remember what I did?" he says "What are you talking about?" That is because we have remission of sin. You know how free we are of sin? As free as Jesus Christ.

This right now is a mirror that is showing you who you really are in the realm of the Spirit.

Ephesians 1:8-11 Wherein he hath abounded toward us in all wisdom and prudence; Having made known unto us the mystery of his will, according to his good pleasure which he hath purposed in himself: That in the dispensation of the fulness of times he might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; even in him: <u>In whom</u> also we have obtained an inheritance, being predestinated according to the purpose of him who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will:

It goes on and on. This is how you go through the letters of Paul and see yourself. You acknowledge who you are. I want to get this point across before we close. If you are in Christ the only thing that is

in you is what's in Christ. If it's not in Christ it's not in you. We are totally one. The way that this becomes effective in our lives Is by acknowledging these truths

# Philemon 6 King James Version <sup>6</sup> That the communication of thy faith may become effectual by the acknowledging of every good thing which is in you in Christ Jesus.

#### Philemon 6

Amplified Bible, Classic Edition

<sup>6</sup> [And I pray] that the participation in *and* sharing of your faith may produce *and* promote full recognition *and* appreciation *and* understanding *and* precise knowledge of every good [thing] that is ours in [our identification with] Christ *Jesus* [and unto His glory].

Notice this is where we get the term "acknowledging what is in you." The booklet from Brother Curry. Acknowledging what is in you.

You become effective by acknowledging every good thing in you in Christ Jesus. If there is any good in you it's because you are in Christ Jesus. When you acknowledge who you are and the good that is in you in Christ Jesus your faith becomes effective. How many people want effective faith? Strong robust faith.

Your faith becomes effective by acknowledging your identity in Christ. Those of you that are discipling others I'm sure you want the people you are discipling to be effective. We want them to be established. Paul said you be established by my gospel. So, what we are lacking in the church is revelation of Paul. Paul's revelation now needs to become our revelation. We are over fed with information and starving for revelation. Someone once said underfed sheep and constipated shepherds. For the church to grow and become who God wants us to be we have dive into the writing of Paul. Let's make a decision to start acknowledge every good thing in us. Let's start going through the letters of Paul, and let Jesus show us who we are and as that light comes darkness will go bondages will be broken. Sickness will leave. Just by seeing who you are in Christ.

Say

"I am joined to the Lord I am one Spirit with him I have in me everything that Jesus has in him I have his life I have his love I have his peace I have his authority I have his authority I have his righteousness I am one with him I am free from guilt and shame I am a new creation I am new species of being I am a new breed upon this earth The word is being made flesh in me Me and Jesus are one We cannot be separated We are joined together Hallelujah"

The older I am getting as a Christian the more I am realising I should have spent more time in the letters of Paul because that will establish in me. To build you up and give you an inheritance.
