

New Covenant Mindset

Before this call we have the India call and, in the morning, I start praying. That is how I work. I start praying in the morning. Praying in the Spirit and really getting wisdom on what I am supposed to share. You have to know that I have so many things that I could go but I am beyond that now I want a word from God for God's people. I have gone beyond just giving a nice sermon. Nothing was coming up and I was quite feeling frustrated and then five minutes before the India call, I got a download of what I am supposed to talk about so I am going to share a few thoughts with you today to point us in the right direction. I believe it is from the Lord.

We are going to talk about a new covenant mindset. A new covenant mindset. An old covenant mindset is what we are hoping God is going to do. A new covenant mindset is what God has already done. An old covenant mindset is that I am hoping God will heal me. A new covenant mindset is that God has already healed me. I have seen this that even those that claim to be new covenant believers still live like old covenant people. They have the terminology; they have the word 'New covenant' but their thinking is still old covenant. We have to realise what side of the cross are we living in. Amen. I believe that these are profound truths that once grasped, once applied can change our life.

Let's start with Romans chapter 8 verse 32

Romans 8:32

He who did not spare his own Son but gave him up for us all, how will he not also with him graciously give us all things?

Amen. 'With him' My bible says "Graciously, freely gave us all things." As far as God is concerned, he *has* given us *all* things. Watch this. He *has* given us all things. Not *going to* give us all things. *Has* given us all things.

Let's look at our second passage of scripture. 2nd Peter chapter 1

I will read from chapter 1. I am reading from the ESV so there might be some differences but we are all saying the same things.

2 Peter 1:1

Simeon Peter, a servant and apostle of Jesus Christ, To those who have obtained a faith of equal standing with ours by the righteousness of our God and Savior Jesus Christ:

Isn't that amazing. He says he is a servant before he is an apostle. Amen. Some people get caught up with all the titles.

2 Peter 1:2

May grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord.

Grace and peace. Grace we can say is God's unmerited. Undeserved favour. Nothing to do with you. It isn't a wage. If it was a wage, it wouldn't be grace. Grace and peace be multiplied to you.

Not Subtracted. Not divided but multiplied. That is God's mathematics. Amen. God is a God of multiplication. Grace and peace. Watch this, be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord.

2 Peter 1:3

His divine power has granted to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of him who called us to his own glory and excellence,

His divine power has granted to us all things. Everyone say "All things" You don't need an English lesson to know what that means. "All things" means nothing left out. "All things." All things that pertain to life and Godliness. So as far as God is concerned when he gave us Jesus, he graciously freely gave us all things. That is what Paul said. Peter says that he has given us all things that pertain to life and Godliness. All things that pertain to your life has already been given. Most Christians are trying to convince God to give them something that he has already given them. While the Holy Spirit is trying to convince that's already been given. Amen. That is what the Holy Spirit is doing. He is trying to get our attention. He is trying to say "You already have it." If we have Jesus, you have everything. Jesus is everything that we ever need. Healing is not just something. Healing is him. Say "Already have it"

Let's have a look at another passage of scripture.
Ephesians chapter 1 verse 3.

Ephesians 1:3

Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly places,

Ephesians 1:3

Amplified Bible, Classic Edition

³ May blessing (praise, laudation, and eulogy) be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ (the Messiah) Who has blessed us in Christ with every spiritual (given by the Holy Spirit) blessing in the heavenly realm!

Technically if you are in Christ, you cannot be any more blessed. I know we all have used that language when someone sneezes, we say "God bless you" and "keep blessed." We use that language but if we are looking at new covenant mindset. A new covenant believer can not be any more blessed. We are blessed with every spiritual blessing amen. *Every*. What most people are waiting on God for; they must realise they already have.

2 Kings 6:8-13

Once when the king of Syria was warring against Israel, he took counsel with his servants, saying, "At such and such a place shall be my camp."

But the man of God sent word to the king of Israel, "Beware that you do not pass this place, for the Syrians are going down there."

And the king of Israel sent to the place about which the man of God told him. Thus he used to warn him, so that he saved himself there more than once or twice.

And the mind of the king of Syria was greatly troubled because of this thing, and he called his servants and said to them, "Will you not show me who of us is for the king of Israel?"

*And one of his servants said, "None, my lord, O king; but Elisha, the prophet who is in Israel, tells the king of Israel the words that you speak in your bedroom."
And he said, "Go and see where he is, that I may send and seize him." It was told him, "Behold, he is in Dothan."*

Get the backdrop here. You do realise how dumb the devil is. Every time he was making the plan the prophet knew what plan he was making and now he makes another plan to go and find the prophet. Surely the prophet would have known that he is making a plan. It just shows you how dumb the devil is. Now they go and search for Elisha.

2 Kings 6:14 -16

So he sent there horses and chariots and a great army, and they came by night and surrounded the city.

When the servant of the man of God rose early in the morning and went out, behold, an army with horses and chariots was all around the city. And the servant said, "Alas, my master! What shall we do?"

He said, "Do not be afraid, for those who are with us are more than those who are with them."

So now the servant of Elisha wakes up, and he is stretching out and he looks over and he notices a whole army has surrounded them. So, he goes and wakes up Elisha and he says "Master, they have surrounded us" and Elisha says "There are more with us than there is with them" I would just like to see the face of this servant at this moment. He would have thought, 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7. He was thinking what is going on? How can you say there is more than there is with them.

2 Kings 6:17

Then Elisha prayed and said, "O LORD, please open his eyes that he may see." So the LORD opened the eyes of the young man, and he saw, and behold, the mountain was full of horses and chariots of fire all around Elisha.

Amen. Watch this. The chariots of fire were there, even before the servants' eyes were opened. *Blessed the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing.* Just because you don't see it doesn't mean its not there. Good evening. Watch this. Everything we need unto life and Godliness has already been provided. We just need eyes to see what is already there. Is anyone with me on this? Just because you can't feel it, doesn't mean you are not healed. Just because you can not see it doesn't mean that its not there. When God gave us his son, he gave us everything. We just need our eyes to be opened to know what we already have. You know we have this idea that Jehovah Jira is the Lord who provides. Jehovah Jira does not mean the Lord who provides. Jehovah Jira means the Lord who provides *in advance*. Before you were born God had already provided everything you ever need. Before you were even a twinkle I your mothers eye God has already taken care of your future. The old Covenant mindset is "I'm hoping it will happen one day" A new covenant mindset is "It has happened and it is done." That is where we have to live. What side of the cross are we living? Are we living on the side where we are waiting for God to do something or are we living on the side where it has already happened and done? See many people are trying to be healed. God has already healed. Many are trying to be delivered God has already delivered. You know we hear this prophesy "The Lord is saying I am going before you, I am going to make all the crooked places straight" Listen, he made the crooked places straight 2000 years ago when Jesus Christ came. He is not making any crooked places straight today my friend, it is done. It has happened, it is accomplished. What we

need if anything; we need our eyes to open to see what we already have. That is revelation. Revelation, is you seeing what you already have. "Oh, I'm just waiting for the manifestation." We use all these different terms. Listen, new covenant faith, write this down, this is very important. New covenant faith is not God will do; it is what God has done. New covenant faith is not what God will do. That is old covenant faith. Hallelujah. It is what God will do. New covenant faith is what God has already done. And he said "Grace and peace be multiplied to you through our Lord Jesus Christ" then he says "who has given unto us all things."

What am I saying? There is not much that God is going to do. It is what he has already done and what he has already provided and what he has already given. Just like the servants' eyes needed to be opened to what was already there. We need our eyes to open. That is the primary work of the Holy Spirit. Primary work of the Holy Spirit is to show you that you have already got it and now start believing that and acting that. A lot of our prayer and our communion with God would just be thanks giving. Amen. Not "Gimme gimme gimme, my names Jimmy." "Blessed us four, no more." That type of praying goes out of the window. The day I realised I have Jesus; I have everything. Amen. That is New Testament. That is a new covenant mindset. I'm not trying to get. You need to tell the devil. When the devil says to you "Ha ha ha you are not going to get it." You need to say "Ha ha ha, I have already got it." He will say "Ha ha ha you are not going to be healed. hah aha ha you are never to experience this." You need to say "Ha ha ha. I am not trying to get it. Jesus already got it for me. It is his grace" Hallelujah. So new covenant faith is not what God will do; it is what God has already done. If he gave us his son, freely with him he will give us all things. well, the question now lies, the million-dollar question is how do we bring what is in the Spirit realm into the natural realm?

Bringing The Spiritual Realm Into The Natural Realm

The million-dollar question. If we already have it, how can it be materialised where we can experience it? Okay let's have a look

Romans chapter 5 verse 2

You know when I first started learning these truths the first thing that I noticed was my prayers need to change. That is the first thing I realised. My goodness, my prayers needed to change because I was so used to begging. Listen I am not a beggar I am a son. If I am a son then I am a joint heir with Christ Jesus. equal inheritance. Is anyone with me on this. is this making sense. Listen this has to take place if we are going to walk in this.

How do we access this? How do we experience now all these things that are already ours?

Roman 5:2

Through him we have also obtained access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in hope of the glory of God.

Everyone say "Access" The way you access the grace of God; Access everything that has been given to you is by faith. Faith is the bridge; faith is the door. Faith is the pin number. Hallelujah. You can have a lot of money in your account but you have the pin number you can access that which is already there. "Obtained access by faith into this grace" say that. when we say grace that is God's unmerited undeserved favour. Every Jesus has already paid for and accomplished. The only way that we can access that is by faith. *In which we stand, S T A N D*. Watch this; you access by faith, and you stand. What is the next word? "and we rejoice

in hope of the glory of God.” We Rejoice. When you got born again by faith, you accessed that grace. Now you stand and you rejoice. Everything in the kingdom operates the same way. Is this good news or is this good news. In other words, we are not waiting on God to do anything. We are just accessing our inheritance by faith and we stand and we rejoice. Hallelujah, thank you Jesus. Thank you, Lord. What am I saying? Everything you will ever need from the moment you were born again till the time that you go and meet Jesus has already been given. Has already been provided. It has got your name on it. Hallelujah. It is there waiting with your name on it. It has got your name on it. Your inheritance has your name. We access this by faith. The faith is not God is going to do, the faith is God has already done. Listen this will change your attitude. Amen. This will change your attitude to know that everything you ever need has already been given. God is not holding it back. He is a good good Father.

Hebrews 11:1

Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Hebrews 11:1

Amplified Bible, Classic Edition

Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, the title deed) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see *and* the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses].

Everyone say “Faith is the title deed.” The title deed means that you have ownership of something. Is that right? I’m not very legal but I know a little bit. If you have a title deed for something. Watch this. I don’t need to live in the house or to see the house to have ownership of the house. I can just have the title deed and the title deed proves that its my house. Does this make sense? I can have a house in Italy. I cannot live in the house and live in the UK but that house is mine if I have the title deed. The word of God is our title deed that shows us what is already ours. The problem is that most people have not read the title deed and they are just hoping and praying that one day they will be blessed. One day they will be prosperous. One day they will be healed. watch this. Faith gives us access.

What am I saying? Everything you need has already been provided.

2 Corinthians 4:18

as we look not to the things that are seen but to the things that are unseen. For the things that are seen are transient, but the things that are unseen are eternal.

We look not at the things which are seen but the things which are unseen.

You know when I read this many years ago this verse confused me so much. How can you look at things which are unseen. I was so confused. It says *we do not look at the things which are seen but the things which are unseen*. Not seeing with the natural eye but seeing with the eyes of faith. Watch this, *The things that are seen are temporary*. What you can see is temporary. That means its subject to chang and the things which are unseen are eternal. Hallelujah. Then it goes onto chapter 5 verse 7

2 Corinthians 5:7

for we walk by faith, not by sight.

If you are going to walk with God there is only way to walk with God it is by faith and not by sight. You can’t walk with God by sight. You are not walking with God. You are walking with the devil because the devil enables you, wants you to live by sight. This book, (the bible) is more real than anything that

we can see in the natural. You know, right now I am sitting here; you can see me with your physical eyes but if your eyes were opened in the Spirit realm over here and over here are two angels. Come on. That is what you can't see. I can see you but every believer has angels going with them. Even when you go to the toilet, they go with you. Come on, they are with us 24/7. Say this with me "I walk by faith and not by sight. Everything I will ever need I already have in Christ. I'm not trying to get. I thank God for I have it. I stand. I rejoice." This is growing up now. We are growing up. We are not like children now. Walking by sight. The more you grow up the less you will walk by sight. Let me say this again. Faith is not what is God going to do? New Covenant faith is; What God has already done. Faith is the bridge. Once you start believing "I have it" then you will see it in the natural. Once you start believing its already done you will experience it because that is the bridge that is the door. That is the pin number. F A I T H.

The bible is our title deed. What shows us what we already have.

Psalm 119:105

Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

In other words, Gods word gives light on the path that you are walking. On the bridge for it to cross over from the spirit realm to the natural realm. It's a light to our path.

You can meditate on these verses.

Psalm 119:130

The unfolding of your words gives light; it imparts understanding to the simple.

Light is vision. Come on. Light shows you what is already there. God's word shows you what you already have. You know what God's word is saying. "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing." Technically you can't be more blessed. You are the most blessed and now it's not about receiving blessings. Now its about being a blessing. If we are always running around trying to be blessed, we can never be a blessing and the devil would rather have us running around trying to get what we already have. That is what I wanted to share with you for this year. That we have eyes to see what we already have. There is nothing that we lack. Amen.

Taking communion together

Grab your bread and let's take the Lord's supper together. Lift up your bread in your hand.

Father, we thank you for this covenant meal. Father, we thank you for Jesus for his life for his obedience. For his sacrifice. Father as we take this bread and we receive this bread. Thank you, Lord, that we are reminded that Jesus bore our sicknesses and our pains. That through his sacrifice we have been healed. By his stripes we were healed. Thank you. Thank you that it is done. It is accomplished. It is finished. It is ours. Thank you that the same Spirit that raised Christ from the dead lives in us and it quickens our bodies; quickens our cells, nerves joints, organs, muscles, bones, in Jesus' name. Thank you Lord. Hallelujah. Thank you that we are healed. We are not the sick trying to get healed we are the healed. In Jesus' name. Amen. Hallelujah. Thank you, Jesus. Thank you, Lord. Hallelujah. Hallelujah. Thank you. Thank you, Lord it is done. Thank you, Jesus, that you obtained an eternal redemption for us. You delivered us you healed us. Just lift up your drink and let's thank God

Thank we thank you for the blood of your son. Thank you for his shed blood. The sacrifice. The blood of the new covenant. Thank you that we have remission of sins. Freedom from sin. Thank you that everything we will ever need has already been provide in this new covenant. Father thank you that as the beginning of this year we receive communion. We believe and we know that all of our needs are already met. You have already provided everything for us. You have given unto us all things unto Godliness, unto life and Godliness. Thank you that we are satisfied and full. Thank you, Lord, that we are healed. Delivered, protected, restored, redeemed, chosen. Thank you, Lord. In Jesus' name. Amen. Hallelujah. Hallelujah. Thank you, Jesus. thank you, Lord.

What a glorious covenant that we have.

Let's make sure that we have a new covenant mindset. Let's live on the right side of thee cross. The right side of the cross is that we have everything that we need and we can access what is ours by faith. A lot of our time should be a time of thanksgiving

Thank you, Lord. Thank you I have it. Thank you it is mine. Thank you is working in me. I am not trying to get I already have. Hallelujah. Amen is anyone with me on this. Watch this we are not going into this new covenant hoping that God is going to look after us. Listen are you crazy? He will look after you. He is in you. Listen, let's go into this new year and look at ways that we can bring glory to his name and be a blessing to others.

Father, I thank you Lord for your people. I thank you that your Spirit is at work in each and every one of us. Thank you, Lord, for this new covenant. Thank you for this new life. Thank you for this new freedom. Thank you for our inheritance. Thank you that you have provided everything that we will ever need. It is ours. It belongs to us and we access it by faith believing that we have already got it. thank you, Holy Spirit, that you are at work in our life. Thank you for revelation thank you that your Spirit reveals to us through the word of God what we already have in Jesus' name. Amen. praise God.

Well, I am stirred up and encouraged. It is a glorious thing of what our saviour has done for us. We are not hoping and wishing and twiddling our thumbs hoping it will come though. Its done. Romans 8:32
2 Peter 1:1-3, Ephesians 1:3

If there is any question ask the Lord to open your eyes so you can see what is already there. This Is how we are starting the year. We are not beggars, we are sons. If we are sons, we have Jesus then we have everything. This type of teaching will change your prayer life because now you are going to get stuck when praying; "What do I prayer for now?" Listen one thing you can pray is thanksgiving for what is already yours.
