

## **Developmental Principles in the Hub and Spokes**

Core: field of expertise.

Spoke: a dimension of learning

Detailed *description* of an activity define its modes of practice

**Rectangle:** a *mode of practice* with the most complex modes toward the center.

- Beginning modes are the most prevalent at the onset of education in the expertise, but the do not grow in frequency or A with other modes
- Exploring modes grow very rapidly and often overshoot resources such as social acceptance but they do not compete with more complex modes.
- Sustaining modes grow moderately and compete with simpler modes.
- Inspiring modes grow moderately and compete with all other practices in a dimension.

Iterative learning improves the speed and accuracy of performing any mode

Transformative learning with four DEEP commitments is necessary to acquire any more complex practice. To do so we,

- o Recognize a Dilemma
- Examine it through reflection and discussion to formulate a new mode
- Enable the new mode through planning and practice with expert help.
- o Perform it.

Depletion results from overusing the first three modes and creates respectively the problems of social rejection, evil, and collective boredom; but there is never excess inspiration.

Massive collaboration require using this framework can result in inspiring solutions to problems of human activity
