1. **You must be accepted at 6 or more schools.** (We will show you how to apply without fees) Even if you already know where you want to attend, Six or more offers are required.
2. **You must file the FAFSA and other required school applications.** (Required for ANY scholarships) This is a college application and award requirement.
3. **You must follow our recommended negotiation strategies** throughout your college career. Extends throughout your college career.
