- The student must be an enrolled student at a post-secondary institution of higher education that meets federal guidelines and qualifies to take part in federal programs including PELL and all Federal Higher Education Act programs. The student must be a U.S citizen or eligible non-citizen with required registration. Undocumented candidates are subject to the requirements of the schools selected.
