Alumnus donates \$1 million to college

The Auburn College of Business is \$1 million richer, thanks to Bennie Bray, a 1972 Auburn graduate and Texas businessman.

The money will help fund undergraduate honors scholarships and establish a faculty professorship.

The first of the scholarships funded by the endowment will be awarded in the spring.

"It will be a competitive scholarship fund for students with good GPAs, things of that nature," said John S. Jahera, interim dean of the College of Business. Jahera made the announcement of Bray's gift.

Dr. Gary L. Waters, executive director of corporate and student services, said Bray is looking to give back to his community.

"He's a very loyal Auburn alumnus," Waters said. "He saw this as an opportunity to allow students to get the same educational experience he went through."

The endowment will help the College of Business in numerous ways.

Waters said he feels the endowment will "enhance our (Auburn's) ability to attract quality students."

"The professorships will enable everyone to retain faculty and to reward them," Jahera said. Jahera strongly
