Your admission is to the J. Mack Robinson College of Business to pursue a major in (Pre) Computer Information Systems with a Concentration in Application Development. Your acceptance is valid for the Fall (August) 2024 semester only. If you choose not to attend, your documents will remain on file for one year. You can delay your entry term for up to two semesters using the [reactivation form](#). If you choose to start later than this, you must submit a new application.

Your admission offer comes with a \$500 renewable GSU Foundation Scholarship. To accept your scholarship you are required to complete the [Intent to Enroll](#) form by **May 1, 2024**. You may access the form [here](#) to secure your funds for enrollment.

Please note that your acceptance is contingent upon successful completion of the 17 units of the required high school curriculum (RHSC) curriculum and proof of graduation from high school.

For a smooth transition to Georgia State, review your Next Steps by visiting [admissions.gsu.edu/next-steps](#). Your first step should be activating your campusID and student email account to begin receiving official university correspondence. Please allow 48-72 hours from receipt of this letter before attempting to find your campusID to allow time for it to generate. Your campusID will be different from your Panther number. Your Panther number is the nine-digit number located below.

Students seeking the in-state tuition rate must also prove lawful presence by following the guidelines on [admissions.gsu.edu/lawful-presence](#). Many students will not need to take any action since we'll be able to verify the information from your submission of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Information will be sent to you by email and postal mail if we need additional documentation during the verification process.





Based on your outstanding achievements, you are invited to consider our innovative 4-year (3+1) Bachelor's/Master's accelerated dual-degree program. If you meet the program requirements (maintaining at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA at the end of each undergraduate year), your scholarship will continue in the graduate year (you must also maintain a 3.0 overall GPA each graduate semester). In addition, there are other significant incentives associated with the program, including waived course overload fees during the Fall and Spring semesters up to 19 credits per term. You will find detailed information at qu.edu/scyber Response required for program participation – please complete the reply form on your applicant portal by June 1, 2024.

Based on your strong achievements, you will receive a \$30,000 Presidential Scholarship per year (\$120,000 over four years), to be applied toward tuition, for completion of your bachelor's degree program. This scholarship is renewable based on maintaining full-time enrollment, a 2.5 grade point average, and satisfactory academic progress (completion with a passing grade of at least 24 semester hours in course work each academic year).

The Office of Financial Aid will provide a detailed financial aid offer letter once we have received your 2024/25 FAFSA from www.fafsa.gov. The offer letter will notify you of any need-based financial aid funds for which you may qualify. Deposits for the Fall semester are due May 1st. 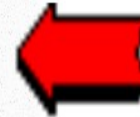
