



CNA, Certified Nursing Assistant

Certified Nursing Assistants (CNA) are responsible for many patient care tasks to ensure that each patient receives the comprehensive and personalized care they need. They often have the following responsibilities:

- Grooming and bathing patients with limited mobility
- Preparing each patient room with necessary items like blankets, pillows, medical equipment and bathroom needs
- Helping patients eat and hydrate
- Making sure they have regular meals and are attended to promptly
- Monitoring vitals and patient behavior and reporting them to the charge nurse
- Assisting patients with mobility needs, transferring them from wheelchair to bed
- Turning or adjusting patients in bed to prevent bedsores or other discomfort
- Exercising patients by helping them with ADL's
