Flash Cards Instructions

There are four (4) questions for each flash card:

1. Is the note in the "G" clef or the "F" clef?
2. Is it a line note or a space note?
3. What is the rule?
4. What is the name of the note?

ANSWERS:

1. Each note is written on either the treble ("G") clef or the bass ("F") clef. Student looks at the card and determines on which clef the note is written.
2. Line notes have a line through the middle of them, and space notes are in the spaces between the lines. Space notes DO NOT have a line through them.
3. "Rule" is the mnemonic device used to remember the names of the lines and spaces. (See Chart)

Reading from the bottom to the top, these rules are:

G clef line notes: Every Good Boy Does Fine

G clef space notes: F, A, C, E, (FACE)





F clef line notes: Great Big Dogs From Alaska

F clef space notes: All Cows Eat Grass

***EXCEPTION: Notes outside the staff lines have NO RULE. They must be memorized or figured by the instructions for ledger line notes.

4. The name of the note is the first letter of the word of the rule, i.e., if the note is on the line for the word "Every," then that note is an "E."

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NOTE: Read rules from bottom to top.




Ledger Line Flash Cards Instructions

There are four (4) questions:


1. Is the note in the G (treble) clef or the F (bass) clef?
2. What line are we starting from?
3. Are we counting forward or backward?
4. What is the name of the note?

ANSWERS:

1. If the ledger line note is above or under the G clef, it is in the G clef. If it is above or below the F clef, it is in the F clef.
2. Start counting from the outside staff line and ledger lines that lead to the note, proceeding like this: **line, space, line, space, etc.**
 - a. For a note that is above the treble staff, the starting line is "F."




- b. For a note that is between the staves and is under the treble staff, the starting line is "E."





- c. For a note that is between the staves and is above the bass staff, the starting line is "A."




- d. For a note that is under the bass staff, the starting line is "G."



3. Student counts lines and spaces, going either forward or backward in the alphabet, and arrives at the name of the note.
 4. Student should now be able to say the name of the note.
- REMEMBER: DO NOT skip lines or spaces when counting as with the regular flash cards. Count: line, space, line, space, line, space, etc.

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



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Ukulele Chords 3-part cards






Chord diagrams are grids that represent chords to be played on the ukulele.






Dots on a chord diagram indicate where the fingers are to be placed to depress the strings.
