Rules of Entries: Limit two (2) works per student. \$0 fee per entry. All works must be the original creations of the artist. No copies will be accepted. Unframed works must be matted and backed with foam core or sturdy mat board. Work will not be accepted unless these procedures are followed. Table easels will be available.  2 - 2D media – grades 6-8
 5 - 3D media – grades 6-8

 3 - 2D media – grades 9-12
 6 - 3D media – grades 9-12

2D media includes drawing, painting, collage, ink, multi-media flat (works must be matted with a sturdy back NO GLASS).

3D media includes ceramics and other clay works, construction, masks, sculpture of any media.

Local artists will be sharing their favorite artwork. So, invite your family, friends, and neighbors for an afternoon of fun. There is no limit to the number of attendees. This event will be open to the public!

NOTE: this show will be received by very young children so content of works for this show should reflect positive thoughts and deeds. Please keep in mind that content should be free of drugs, alcohol, weapons, gang symbols, and overt sexuality or violence. Instructors should critique works before entering this show. Give 4 Kidz reserves the right to remove objectionable artwork.
